Adopting an exotic pet from PPAR ADOPTION POLICIES

Please note that these policies are set in place for the expressed purpose of the care and well-being of our rescues. We care very deeply for all our animals and wish to find them loving adoptive homes that can provide for the unique needs of their species.

1. All interested adoptive homes must fill out an <u>ADOPTION QUESTIONARRE</u> before they can adopt an animal from Pocket Pets Animal Rescue.

2. All adoptive homes must be screened for suitability by a PPAR designated authority. No animal will be placed until the home has been approved.

3. All adoptive persons must sign an <u>ADOPTION AGREEMENT</u> before they can take one of our available animals home.

4. Any animal adopted from PPAR must be returned to the rescue if the adoptive owner does not wish to keep their pet.

5. All animals adopted from PPAR must either be spayed/neutered or kept with other same sex animals so that breeding does not occur. No animal adopted from PPAR may be used for commercial or personal breeding purposes. Any animal bred after adoption will be in violation of the adoption contract. Adoptive owners who violate this contract are subject to removal of the adopted animal and any legal fees accrued in the return of the animal to PPAR.

6. All <u>adoption fees</u> are set by PPAR and are non-negotiable. PPAR will not trade animals or adopt animals out to homes that cannot cover the adoption fee. Some other agencies may assist with our adoption fees, please inquire with PPAR for more information.

7. All adoptive homes must identify a veterinarian in their area that they intend to use for any medical care for their pet. After adoption, all veterinary costs are the responsibility of the adoptive owner.

8. No animal will be adopted without veterinary inspection prior to said adoption. This fee is included in the adoption fee.

9. Due to possible dangers in shipping animals, all adoptable animals will <u>*not*</u> be shipped to adoptive owners.
