New Member - Application

Procedure for applying to join Peninsula Pistol Club

1. FORM 1 to be completed in **DUPLICATE** by the applicant.
2. FORM 1A is to be taken to your nearest Police Station, where a Police Officer will take the applicant's fingerprints and will complete the lower portion of FORM 1A and return the form to the applicant.
3. The following is then forwarded to the Peninsula Pistol Club
 - a. FORM 1 (Both copies)
 - b. FORM 1A
 - c. 3 passport size photographs
 - d. A cheque covering the joining fee \$175 plus annual subscription \$240 (or pro-rata if applying part way through the year) = Total of \$415 less pro-rata, if applicable.
4. All applications to join the Peninsula Pistol Club will be tabled for approval at the next Management Committee Meeting which are held on the last Tuesday of each month.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. All applicants under the age of 18 must have a parent join (for supervision purposes) that must continue to be a member of the club until the junior has reached the age of 18.
2. Fees are, joining fee \$175. Annual fees for juniors and spouses are \$135:00 with no joining fee.
3. All members are expected to attend at least half of the working bees held year (currently 4 working bee's are held each year) unless paying an extra \$100 each year for exemption from working bee's and duty officer functions.
4. All members are expected to be Duty Officer for one day each calendar year unless paying the exemption fee covered in item 3.
5. All new members must attend a Firearms Safety session and attend a Range Safety Day.
6. All new members must apply for a Temporary Handgun licence (licences issued for up to 9 months duration)
7. After 6 months, and provided the member has attended the required number of range participation attendances, the member may apply for a full Handgun licence for target pistol shooting.
8. Club pistols are available for members during training and after obtaining own licence.
9. To retain pistol licences, members must attend a minimum of 10 range participation attendances each year. Please note that the only valid range participation attendances recognised by the Police, are club competitions and/or approved club shoots.
