STERLING SUB MACHINE GUN 9mm Mk 4



The standard sub-machine gun with the British Armed forces and in service in over 90 countries throughout the world.

A light and easily handled weapon which can fire full automatic and single shot, using standard 9mm Parabellum ammunition being operated by case projection or "blow back". With exceptional accuracy and with renowned reliability it continues to function in the most adverse conditions of mud, sand, snow and ice. It is a short to medium range weapon used for engagement at ranges up to 200 metres.

Folding butt for ease of carrying and stowage. Illustrated with optional bayonet, 15 and 34 round magazines.

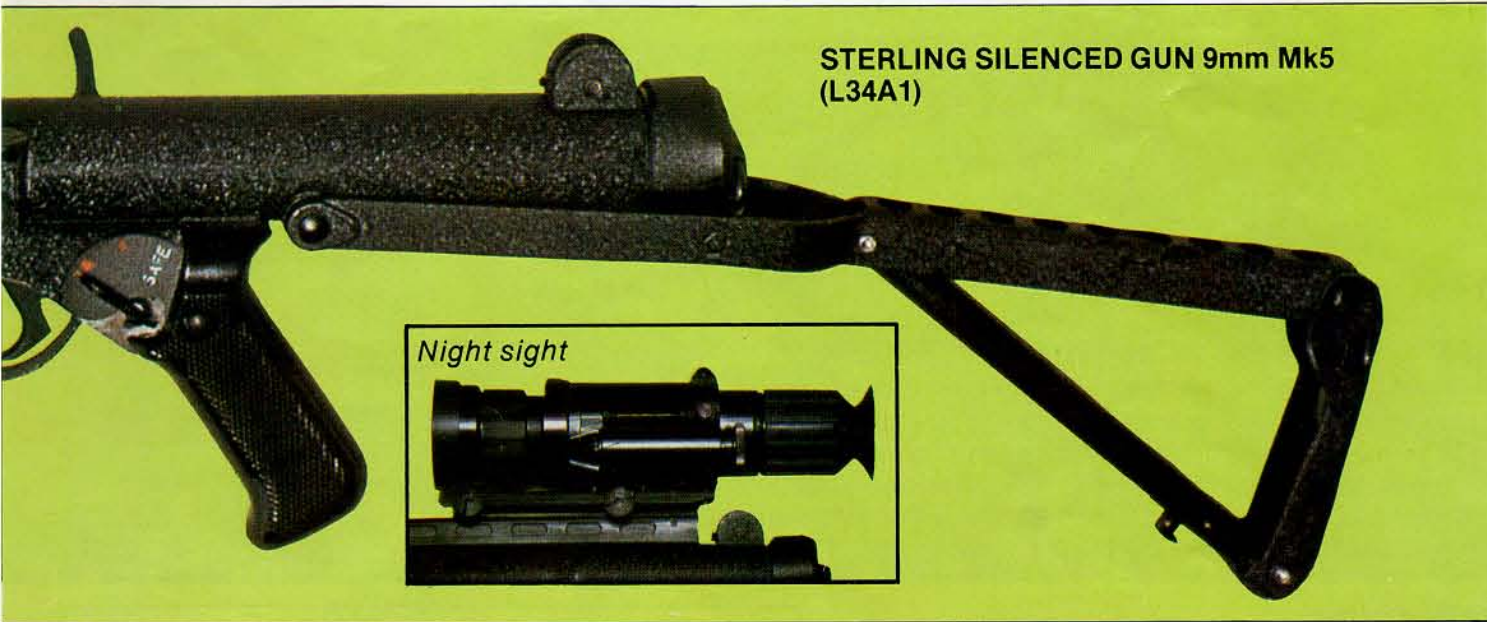


Developed to meet a British General Staff requirement for a fully automatic silent weapon and in service with the British Armed Forces. The bullet is slowed to subsonic speeds by the silencing arrangements giving a truly silent weapon. There is nothing to wear out in the built in silencer and thousands of rounds can be fired without attention except normal cleaning. Using **standard** 9mm Parabellum ammunition a maximum size group at 30 metres (100 feet) of 63.5mm x 63.5mm (2½" x 2½") is achieved on every gun prior to its leaving the factory. The Mark 5 retains all the other features of the Mark 4, for example, the folding butt for ease of carriage, the helical ribs on the bolt for efficient functioning under adverse operational conditions. A close bolt semi automatic version is also available for Police use. Many of the spare parts are fully interchangeable between the Marks 4 and 5 giving continuity of manufacture and availability.

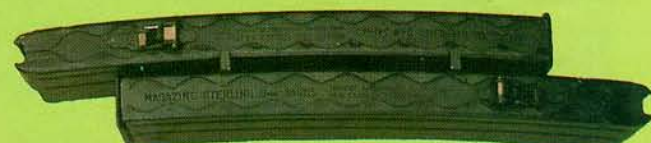
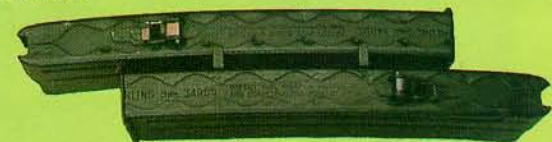
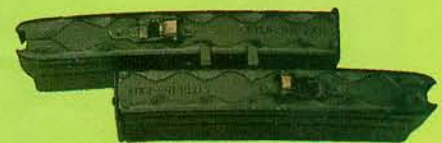
STERLING 9mm PARA PISTOL A8

All A series weapons fire from the open bolt and have the capability of firing single shot or automatic rapid fire at 560 rounds per minute. The A4 and A8 have a forward pistol grip fitted as standard which enables the user to have a rugged hold to have complete control of the gun in continuous rapid fire.

A8 Denotes open bolt firing 7.8 inch barrel length.

STERLING 9mm PARA PISTOL C4

C4 Denotes closed bolt firing 4 1/4 inch barrel length.

The C4 has an overall length of 14 3/4 inches.

The "C" series fires from a closed bolt and has a floating firing pin. All closed bolt units fire in the single-shot mode only. As the bolt is forward and stationary when the firing pin strikes the round it gives the firer maximum accuracy.



STERLING 9mm PARA PISTOL C8

C8 Denotes closed bolt firing 7.8 inch barrel length.

The C8 has an overall length of 18 1/2 inches.

All "C" series guns have 2 locating buttons on the upper side of the gun casing to enable a dovetailed 'scope rail to be fitted. The buttons are ready-drilled and tapped, and the Sterling 'scope rail fits on them direct.

STERLING POLICE CARBINE Mk 7 9mm C8

Sterling 9mm Para Pistol C4 and C8 fitted with a light plastic fixed butt with 3 add on sections to adjust to the user's own arm length.

This unit was designed at the request of police marksmen and also shooting clubs requiring maximum stability in placing shots when the telescopic sight is used.



The butt is removed by pushing out a simple spring retaining locking pin.



'Scope rail dovetailed to accept 12mm scope mounts.

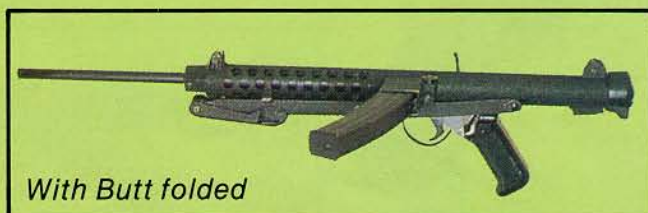

STERLING Mk 8 9mm CLOSED BOLT SINGLE SHOT

The single shot closed bolt Sterling 9mm Mark 8 was developed for greater accuracy in the 100-200 metre range for security forces using standard 9mm parabellum ammunition. Hand guns used by security forces are unreliable in accuracy at these ranges when innocent members of the public are present during terrorist incidents.

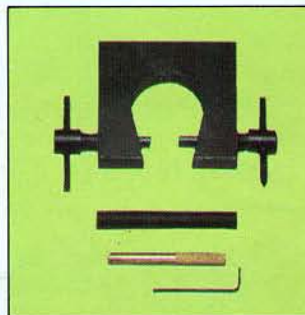

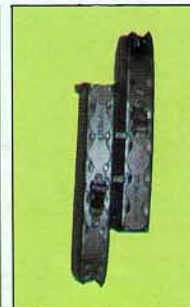
