**Requirements for Membership:**

New members applying for membership must have completed 12 units at Mesa College with a cumulative GPA over the past 5 years of college course work of 3.5 or higher, and be enrolled in at least one semester unit of course work at Mesa. For returning members: must be taking one semester unit course work at Mesa with a cumulative GPA of 3.25 or higher for college course work completed over the past 5 years.

☺ If you do not have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.5 over the last 5 years, or have not completed 12 units at Mesa College, you can apply for membership as a provisional member and do not have to pay the Membership fee of \$65.00.
