

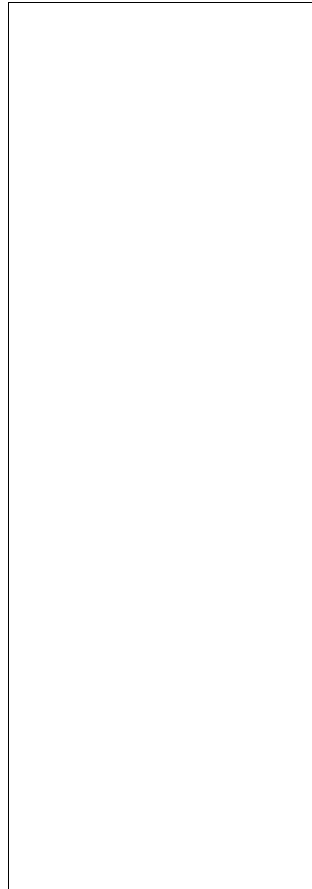
How Can I Join PWP Chapter 001?

To Join PWP, you must be a parent of a living child and be single for whatever reason (divorced, separated, widowed, or never married). Custody is not a factor for membership eligibility. Prospective members must attend an initial orientation meeting, which is held twice per month at various locations around the Baltimore area. 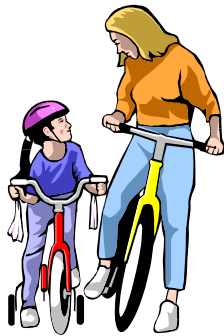

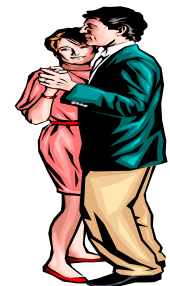
- Dating and Relating
