The meeting was called to order by President Alphy Norman at 6:45 p.m. It was reported by Alphy that Merilee Galloway has been ill with a brain tumor. Tolly Williamson is recovering nicely from her broken right wrist. Cynthia Brown was present and is feeling much better and stronger after her surgery. Jim Kelly stopped by for a minute and said that Virginia was in a lot of pain and is taking codine and may have to have surgery. We all wish them well.

Secretary Nancy Humphrey asked that the Minutes be accepted as read. A motion was made, seconded, and passed that they be accepted as printed in the month's newsletter.
