

## **GUILDLINES FOR ACCREDITATION AS MSBF TRAINING CENTRE**

Training Centres created by MSBF and represented by accredited snooker centres in Malaysia are to be geographically located with aim to cater as evenly as possible the nucleus of urban areas and beyond for the populace to play and compete in snooker

Each Centre has lodge its application with the MSBF for such an accreditation subject to prior compliance with the following terms & conditions:

- The Centre concerned must be licensed with the local authority from where it is operating and to which it is required to comply in every aspect with all licensing conditions so imposed thereon.
- The minimum size of a Training Centre ought to be able to accommodate a minimum 8 snooker tables that are spaced to acceptable standards.
- The said Centre shall be free from gambling, smoking, hard liquor drinking and any other unhealthy activities. If smoking is allowed, a separate confined smoking room is to be provided.
- The Centre shall have an in-house coach licensed by or with the prior approval of the MSBF.
- The Centre shall select 15 athletes per year, under the age of 21, to be systematically and technically trained by its own coach with the best two (2) players selected therefrom, to participate at its own cost in MBSF organized or sanctioned championships.
- The Centre shall provide a registration book whereby players under the age of 21 and below are required to record their names therein while training and being supervised by the Centre.
- The Centre can use MSBF logo to describe its accredited role for publicity and other related purposes provided always such displays must be with the prior approval of the MSBF.
- Prior to approval, the Centre is required to invite a MBSF representative to inspect and approve the suitability of the Centre. Such cost of visitation is to be borne by Centre concerned.
- The Centre is to pay MSBF an annual subscription fee of RM500 in advance, and is subject to annual renewal, if found satisfactory.
- The MSBF reserves its rights to cancel the registration status of any Centre, if it finds its conditions contained herein for accreditation is being infringed by the Centre concerned.
