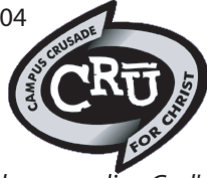

We had 74 students from our ministries in NJ attend down at Harvey Cedars Conference Center in Long Beach, and it was a blessed weekend of teaching and fellowship. Although the numbers from Rutgers was lower than expected, we had a great group of freshmen come to the retreat along with over 30 students from Chinese Christian Fellowship.
