

### Taylor's story:

During Big Break, one of my students, Taylor (sophomore) shared with me how God had worked in his life in the past year. Although he was active in his youth group during high school and attended a few Campus Crusade meetings in his first semester of his freshman year, he began partying and drinking with his roommates and also became addicted to an online computer game. This consumed a vast majority of his time to the point where he began doing terribly in his classes. Needless to say, his relationship with God decayed.

At the end of last semester, myself and another student was thinking of people to invite to come eat with our campus bible-study. Taylor came to mind, so we contacted him for the first time in almost a year. Surprisingly, he agreed to join us.

He told me later on that the week leading up to this event, God had been convicting Taylor of his time spent on the video game and the lifestyle he was leading. When he received a call from us to invite him to a CCC event, he realized that this was a sign from God telling him to turn back to Him. The following week, he attended our large group meeting and heard a fellow student speak about obedience to God. Taylor realized this was God speaking to him again, telling him to give up the sin he was living in and follow Christ.

Taylor is now actively involved in our campus bible study, witnessing to his roommates, and planning on serving God this summer on missions trip to Guatemala with his church and to Hampton Beach Summer Project (New Hampshire) with Campus Crusade.

I am encouraged and overjoyed by stories like this, seeing God work in students' lives. There are so many students who are in Taylor's shoes, who are lost on the college campus; trying but failing to live a Christian life or not even knowing who God is. This is the reason why we are on campus, to direct and guide college students in the right direction and point them towards Christ.
