Boyd receives royal award



Great Britain's Queen Elizabeth II recently bestowed Rotary International President William B. Boyd with the Companion of the Queen's Service Order Award.

The award is given to New Zealand residents who have served as a valuable volunteer to the community, whether in elected or public office. The queen appoints 30 people each year.

"While Lorna [Boyd's wife] and I are honored for me to receive the QSO, we recognize that this is recognition of the standing of Rotary in our community," says Boyd.

The queen honored Boyd for his work in the New Zealand community, which he's served as a Rotarian since 1971. He's also served in his community as an elder and youth leader in the Presbyterian church, scout master, secretary of several school committees, and 30 years as a rugby referee with the rugby union.

Russell Clarke, president of the Pakuranga Rotary club, New Zealand, says that members are collectively delighted that Boyd has received recognition. "The club is extremely proud of Bill and Lorna's wonderful work for Rotary. The feedback from Rotarians worldwide has been that Bill is a real leader of the Rotary movement. The club is proud that the queen has honored Bill and Rotary with this award."

Rob Crabtree, past governor of District 9920 added, "Bill and Lorna epitomize Service Above Self."

An awards ceremony will take place later in the year, after Boyd completes his term as RI president. He will receive a citation for service to the community as well as a badge and a medal.

Highlights of the meeting

RC Los Baños Makiling and RC Los Baños hold joint fellowship, cooperate on joint projects, and induct new members



February 15 -- RCLB Makiling and RCLB had a joint fellowship to discuss several collaborative projects this year that included the Gawad Kalinga Los Baños Ville in Brgy Putho-Tuntungin and the clean water supply system in the GK village. The GK Rotary Village, which is part of the 240-unit community development project, has already been approved by DG Onye Reyes, who endorsed the project as a districtwide activity.

head the Resource Generation Committee of the project, which has already raised a lot of support, both in cash and kind, through pledges.

During the project launch last February 10, Laguna Governor Ningning Lazaro pledged a multiactivity center, Congressman Timmy Chipeco promised to construct a bridge that would link the village to the main road, UPLB alumni based in the US contributed funds for building an initial 50 houses, the Upsilon Sigma Phi alumni pledged a whole village of 30 houses, the Laguna Water District developed the plan for the clean water system with RCLB, UPLB pledged technical assistance, a philanthropist couple pledged support for building 30 or more houses, and local residents, UPLB alumni, and other organizations pledged support to build houses. The two clubs will also provide assistance in the areas of livelihood and literacy.

During the February 15 joint meeting, former UP President Emil Q. Javier, who also heads the Agham Party List, was the guest speaker. Dr Javier appealed to the two clubs and Rotary for support for the group. Scientists are considered a "marginalized" group, according to him. He said that science can help accelerate the country's development, and having a seat in Congress would assure that science is used as a tool and aid for national development.

Maginoong driver to be launched on February 25

The community project, *Maginoong Driver*, will be formally launched at 10 am this Sunday, February 25, at Baker Hall. This is a joint activity of the Los Baños community spearheaded by RCLB Makiling, the Mayor's office, and UPLB, with the Society of IRRI Nonresearch Professionals (SINoP), Land Transportation Office (LTO), and Los Baños Traffic Management Office.

Mayor Caesar Perez will keynote the launching. Representatives of the major jeepney drivers and operators associations in Los Baños, including tricycle drivers, have been invited to the launch.

The UPLB Development Communication Class 180 is assisting RCLB Makiling and the Office of the Mayor in developing and implementing a communication campaign to help instill values and educate drivers and passengers/ pedestrians about safe driving; and also in developing communication materials to promote the project.

During the launch, an exhibit will highlight the project and other important information about the Search for Maginoong Driver, some guides and tips on safe driving, and traffic signs and symbols. Information materials on safe driving and local ordinances will also be distributed.
