How to make up a Rotary club meeting



So, you've traveled halfway around the world, and now you want to attend a club meeting to get to know local Rotarians? Here's all you need to do:

STEP 1: Get the facts

Check the Official Directory or use the Club Locator at www.rotary.org to get club contact details, including e-mail addresses, phone numbers, and meeting times and places. All are subject to change.

STEP 2: Make contact

Call or e-mail ahead to let the club know you're coming. You could just show up, but you might miss out on a great local meal. (Some clubs need you to contribute, or they might just run out of food.)

STEP 3: Show up

That's it! If you're a club member in good standing, you're welcome at any Rotary club meeting, any time, any place.

What if you've traveled so far afield that no clubs are around, or a club meeting time just doesn't work out? Fortunately, you've got options. You can attend a regular meeting of a local Rotaract or Interact club, Rotary Community Corps, or Rotary Fellowship; you can participate in certain RI, district, or club activities; or you can log on for a virtual activity with a Rotary e-club.

Club hosts two GSE teams

This week, the club hosted the visit of two GSE teams—one from Korea and another from the US.

On March 5, the GSE team from Daejeon Metropolitan City, South Korea, RID 3680, hosted by District 3820, visited Area 1 Group 2 clubs in Los Baños and Bay.

The team visited with RC Bay and RC West Bay in the morning, and with RCLB Makiling and RCLB in the afternoon. Members of RC West Bay and RC Bay took the group on a tour of the International Rice Research Institute (IRRI), including the Riceworld Museum and Learning Center, where the group was given an orientation about the world of rice research and IRRI's mission to help feed the world.

After lunch with members of the four clubs and some Korean scientists working at IRRI, RCLB Makiling brought them on a tour of key sites

in the University of the Philippines Los Baños (UPLB). These included the College of Agriculture Agripark, a one-stop shop for agricultural

technologies and information; the Dairy Training and Research Institute (DTRI); the Makiling Botanic Garden on the slopes of Mt Makiling, which is part of the Makiling Forest Reserve operated by the University; and the DL Umali Hall, the center of UPLB's cultural affairs; and the Continuing Education Center (courtesy of RCLB), where there is an ongoing Philippine-Korea cultural exchange program. The GSE team members were given the opportunity to interact with the program participants from Korea.

On March 6, Area 1 Group 2 clubs, which included RC Calamba and RC Calamba City, RCLB, RCL Makiling, RC Bay, and RC West Bay, tendered a dinner for the group at La Vista in Pansol.

The GSE team from Korea is composed of PP Young Woo Kim, team leader; Sun Ah Lee (business

administration and accounting), Sang Wook Han (science teaching), Min Jeong Kim (business administration and international exchange), and Kwang Lae Kim (social welfare/work).

Meanwhile, on March 8, RCLB Makiling hosted the visit of members of its sister club, RC Makati Legaspi (District 3830) and its GSE team from South California (District 5320). Club members lead by Pres. Lumen Gomez took the group on a tour of the Riceworld Museum and Learning Center and UPLB. The visitors were treated to lunch, Filipino style, at the Kamayan sa Palaisdaan in Bay.

The GSE team is composed of PP Kim De Broux (RC South Coast), Phil Hughston (Classroom consultant and trainer), and Shannon Hanners (Spanish teacher). PP Rose Acoba of RC Makati Legaspi accompanied the team.

Every year, RCLB Makiling and the UPLB Makiling Center for Mountain Ecosystems (MCME) conduct an Outdoor Recreation Encounter (ORE) as a joint project with RC Makati Legaspi for high school students from public schools who are trained in environmental conservation and protection, leadership, and advocacy.

This year's ORE will be organized by RCLB Makiling and MCME at the E. Barretto National High School in Pansol, Laguna, on May 7-12.
