# Minutes of Redfield Jaycees General Membership Meeting January 9, 2007

President Michelle Schmitt called the meeting to order at 6:35pm at Starters. Scott Osborn's sons led the flag pledge and the invocation was given by Jolene Jungwirth.

Members in attendance were: Michelle Schmitt, Robin Harty, Scott Osborn, Todd Higer, Jolene Jungwirth, Todd Harty. Guests included Brenda Osborn and 2 sons.

The agenda was reviewed and Todd Higer moved to approve the agenda, Robin Harty seconded the motion, motion passed.

The minutes from the December meeting were distributed by secretary Jolene Jungwirth. Todd Harty moved to accept the secretary's report, Scott Osborn second, motion passed.

Treasurer's Report was given by Jolene Jungwirth. There are several outstanding checks, including 2 checks that have been outstanding since 2005. The final 2006 balance was \$1294.89 in checking, \$807.42 in savings, and \$71.19 in the convention fund savings account. Motion to approve the Treasurer's Report made by Robin Harty, second by Todd Higer, motion passed.

## OLD BUSINESS:

### MANAGEMENT DEVELOPMENT

2007 Officers include: President Robin Harty, VP Management Mary Zens, VP Membership Todd Higer, VP Community Cindy Shine, VP Individual Vicky Rothacker. 2007 Officers present will be installed. Officers not present will be installed at a later meeting.

LOTS Training was held in Mitchell on December 2. A overview was given by members attending, Jolene Jungwirth, Todd Higer, and Michelle Schmitt.

Thank You Postcards are available from Michelle. Project Chairs are responsible for writing Thank You's to Jaycee members, guests, businesses, or members of the community who help with projects.

2006 Wrap Up was given by 2006 President Michelle Schmitt. Membership decreased to 28 members in 2006, membership will need to be a priority in 2007. Annual Report, CPG's, Projects of the Quarters and other end of Year Paper was submitted to the state officers. President Schmitt personally thanked Senator Cindy Crook for her dedication to the Redfield Jaycees and the Jaycee organization and urged other members to take a moment to thank her also. Personal thank you's went to Todd Higer, Robin Harty, and Jolene Jungwirth for their dedication throughout the year.

The 2006 Final Blue Chip was completed by President Schmitt and submitted to State VP Kevin Freestone. The 2007 Initial Blue Chip was also completed by President Schmitt and submitted to the state. The chapter will need to grow by 10% to 31 to achieve growth in 2007.

Todd Higer gave a summary of the E-Chapter for Jaycees. He and Debbie Pinder have organized a group of potential members online to form an online Jaycee community or chapter. The next step to forming this chapter would be to write a CPG and propose this to the SD Jaycees. Possible projects the "E-Chapter" has considered are Toys for Tots, and Ebay Auctions for charity. Todd reported there are about 10 people interested at the moment.

The Redfield Chamber of Commerce Digital Media Centers are installed and functioning. As of this meeting, the Jaycees, as a non-profit group, will not be charged to use the sign. The policy may change in the future to an annual fee of \$25. Cathy Fink is the contact for the Jaycees to use the Chamber sign for our events. Currently, the Hot Shots competition will be shown on the sign.

### COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT:

Final Report on Santa Day was given. The event was held on December 9, 2006 and the Jaycees took approximately 51 pictures, raising \$107.78 for our chapter. Members present included: Mary Zens, Jolene Jungwirth, Todd Higer, Robin Harty, Michelle Schmitt, Scott Osborn, Jeff Carr, Shari Bryant; guests included: Susi Watson, Ashley and Celsey Pies, Tori Jungwirth.

Local Hot Shots competition will be held on January 21 with the Knight's of Columbus Free Throw competition. Set Up will begin at noon; registration at 12:30; competition at 1:00pm. Discussion on the event included: having more than one hoop, and have the girls competition at one and the boys competition at another, running simultaneously; running the second hoop after the KC contest is over; Todd Higer volunteered to chair this project; workers are needed for this project, Todd Higer will call; Flyers have been sent to the school for announcements, channel 7, the Redfield Press, and the Redfield Parks and Rec Dept, Evette Albrecht has cancelled open gym for that day so the students can compete and will hand out registration forms at the open gym the previous week; flyers will also need to be distributed around town, Todd Higer will ask Vicky Rothacker for assistance; Hot Shots will also be displayed on the new Media Center, Jolene Jungwirth will contact Cathy Fink with the Redfield Chamber of Commerce.

Chantelle Anliker has renewed her membership for January.

Discussion was held on holding another "I Hate Winter" dance at Starters in February. Todd Harty made a motion to hold a dance, Todd Higer seconded; motion passed. Michelle Schmitt will be in contact with Grant Evans at Starters to find a date, Cindy Crook will be in contact with Larry Pahl DJ Service for date and cost. Robin Harty will contact Cindy Shine about chairing this project.

A Karaoke Social was held December 28 to celebrate the End of the Year: those in attendance included: Scott Osborn, (Brenda Osborn, guest), Jolene Jungwirth, Michelle Schmitt, Mary Zens, Jeff Carr. Karaoke socials are fun and hosting another was discussed and tabled.

### INDIVIDUAL DEVELOPMENT:

Year End Convention will be January 26-28, 2007 at Watertown, SD. Those currently planning on attending are Michelle Schmitt, Jolene Jungwirth, and Senator Cindy Crook. Registration Fees are \$60.00 and rooms are \$70/night. The chapter currently has \$71.19 to defray the cost of the rooms.

Ten Outstanding Young South Dakotans was discussed. Redfield will be nominating someone for the 2007 Awards. After discussion, Jolene Jungwirth moved to nominate Wendy Owens, Todd Harty seconded, Robin Harty called the motion to a vote, and the motion passed. Jolene Jungwirth will contact Wendy Owens and submit the nomination.

A short recess in the meeting occurred.

2007 Officers Installed included: Robin Harty, President; Todd Higer, VP Membership; Michelle Schmitt, COB, Secretary/Treasurer; Jolene Jungwirth, Chaplain. Members who were inducted included: Todd Harty and Scott Osborn.

President Robin Harty took office and began the NEW BUSINESS:

### MANAGEMENT:

Punt, Pass, and Kick Sectional Bid will be due at the January convention. Jolene Jungwirth gave a report on the previous years and the bid process. Scott Hartung has volunteered to chair this project. A CPG has been written to submit to the state, this includes plan to charge a fee and explains where the proceeds will go; manpower and equipment needs; location, date and time. The chapter will look at asking other organizations to run the concession stand so more members will be able to help with the project. The armory was also suggested as a location for the computers and registration. Michelle Schmitt made a motion to set the entry fee at \$25 per organization, Todd Higer second, call to vote, motion approved. Michelle Schmitt made a motion to set the date as Sunday September 30, 2007, Scott Osborn second, Robin Harty called to a vote, motion passed. Jolene Jungwirth will complete CPG and submit bid to State at the January Convention.

Several New Project ideas were discussed: Raffle: Cabella's Gift Certificate, which is a good fundraiser during Hunting Season, also discussed to partner with another organization to increase ticket sales, but also would split the

proceeds. This would help with the Chapter's Public Relations and also give back to the community. It was also discussed for this to work, every member may be required to sell tickets.

Auction: contact Booster Club to partner a raffle or auction for 2 hours of Spring Yard Work completed by high school athletes; proceeds then split between booster club/athletics and the Jaycees.

Farm and Home Show: the Redfield Chamber of Commerce has again approached the Jaycees on hosting the Farm and Home show in 2008. The chamber has also committed their support to this project. Robin Harty will look into the costs involved, a letter to find if local businesses are indeed interested, and will communicate more with the Chamber of Commerce. She will report at the next meeting.

Meeting Times were discussed: Meetings will now be held the 2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesday of each month, due to conflicting holidays. The Board of Directors will meet at 5:00pm and the general membership will begin at 5:30pm. Todd Harty made motion to accept the date/time, Scott Osborn seconded, motion passed.

The Chapter will be requiring that the first 7 Questions of a CPG must be submitted (typed) to the chapter board BEFORE a project is ran.

Michelle Schmitt, North East Region Director, was introduced and spoke to the membership about the upcoming year.

Bank Fees were discussed due to the 3 outstanding checks; \$60 of Stop Payments fees will need to be charged to the account for checks #1519, 1545, and 1664. Todd Higer made a motion to place a stop payment on the three above checks; Jolene Jungwirth seconded the motion; motion passed.

### COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT:

State Hot Shots will be held February 24 in Madison, SD. Registration will be due February 10. Fees this year are \$10 per competitor/\$30 maximum. It was discussed that a letter of intent to compete should be signed by the parents. This way we are sure of how many competitors will be going and there will be no last minute scramble to find competitors. Todd Harty made a motion to charge a \$10 deposit to parents' of winners committing to compete; Jolene second; motion passed.

Brenda Osborn reported that the Redfield PTSA is looking to bring an astronaut to speak at the school. Terri Roth is the contact with PTSA and will be inquiring about a donation from the Jaycees. The chapter has shown interest in a donation, but this item was tabled until contact with the PTSA.

### MEMBERSHIP DEVELOPMENT:

2007 Membership Goal: Chapter needs to be at 31 at the end of 2007 to achieve growth. State challenge is for each member to recruit one member.

Karaoke Social was discussed: the Redfield Jaycees will look into holding a contest: a local Jaycee Idol. Turtle Creek Saloon will be contacted to find out if they are interested. Todd Harty made a motion for the Redfield Jaycees to hold a Karaoke contest; Scott Osborn seconded the motion; Robin Harty called to vote; motion passed.

### INDIVIDUAL DEVELOPMENT:

Michelle Schmitt informed the membership of the upcoming competitions at the January convention: New Timers, Speak Up, Master Speak Up, Write Up, Springboard, Brownfield, Armbruster, and Mungenast. Jaycee Idol will be held at the April Convention.

Todd Higer made a motion to adjourn the meeting; Todd Harty second; motion passed. President Robin Harty adjourned the meeting at 9:00pm.
