I have corresponded with Joan Brewer since 1991, primarily by e-mail but also with a few phone calls. She has been a long-time reader and occasional contributor to my ACM Risks Forum ([www.risks.org](http://www.risks.org)), and we have had many interesting discussions over the years. Although I have never met her personally, I certainly feel as if I know her fairly well.
