

SELF PORTRAIT BLOCK

ADD ¼" SEAM ALLOWANCE TO ALL PATTERN PIECES.

This is a 12-1/2" block that is pieced in 3 sections.

Note the diagram on Quilter2 block for placement of background pieces.

Section 1: Piece Arms #6 to Shirt #7. Piece Face #5 to neck of Shirt #7: sew from B to A, then from A to C. Clip at A after sewing. Set in background: Sew from B to D, then to end of arm. Go back to C and sew to E, then from E to end of arm. Set in background #1 to each side of face.

Section 2: Piece Background #2 to each side of Skirt #8.

Section 3: Piece Leg #9 to background #4. Add second leg piece #9. Add background #3 to each side of legs.

Sew Section 1 to Section 2. Add Section 3.

Be sure to put your name on the block. Embellish your block in any way to best represent you.

Printing Pattern: This pattern is in Adobe, but you may have to make adjustments to your printer to it to print correctly. I use an Epson Stylus 880. In the printer layout, I had to tell it to custom fit and print 100%. In another program using the MGI Image Program, I had to tell the layout to be 8.5 x 11.0. After you print your pattern, measure to see if it is according to the pattern. If you have any questions, call Jane Stodghill.
