(Axtell) - The Axtell Longhorns JV was open this week.

Axtell 56, Frost 8

(Axtell) – After a very generous game last week, the Longhorns did not feel generous at all (well, almost at all) this week. In fact, they felt downright ornery and the recipient of this ire was the Frost Polar Bears. The Longhorns offense had the ball for ten series during the game and the longest series lasted THREE plays. In those three plays or less, the offense scored or turned over the ball (so they did have a little charity left in them after all).

Charlie Groce took the opening kick-off at the 16-yard line and returned it to the Polar Bear 31-yard line. On first down, Kyle Voss took it 31 yards to the end zone. But, there was a hanky on the ground. On first down from the thirty-four, Weston Popham found Taylor Dunlap for the score and added the two-point conversion for a quick 8-0 lead. When Brandon Trents on-side kick did not travel 10 yards, Frost began its initial drive from the Horns 49-yard line. The defense smother the Frosties attack and they were forced to punt from their own forty one yard line. Axtell took over and on 3rd down, Popham's intended receiver slipped down and Jeffery Wickware picked the pass, giving Frost the ball at the Longhorn 29-yard line. Sam Stroder found Ty Ritterbach for the final 5 yards. Travis Cassady's reception knotted the game, 8-8. Axtell started its second drive at the own 44 yard line and Porter Miles took the first down handoff and didn't stop running until the Horns had the lead. His extra point made it 15-8. The Polar Bears were unable to move the ball and gave it back to Axtell on downs. Miles took a Popham handoff at midfield and raced to another score. His extra point made it 22-8.

Frost made a nice sustained drive from the Axtell thirty-eight to the Horn eighteen before turning it over on downs again. Axtell made another three play drive that ended with Popham finding Jay Helleck for the score. The extra point kick failed and Axtell led 28-8. Axtell held and appeared primed for another score. Popham found Dunlap for 20 yards and then came the scariest play of the evening. Popham was in the grasp of the Polar Bear defense and attempted to pitch it to Miles who went to his knees attempting to catch it. He was hit and doubled back and did not move after Frost recovered the fumble. The home crowd was relieved when he got up and walked off the field. Frost drove the Horns forty six before giving the ball to Axtell on downs. Popham took the snap and weaved through the defense for 56 yards and Trent's kick made it 35-8 with seconds left in the half.

Frost dropped the ball and Axtell took over on the Bear fifteen. A penalty moved them back 15 yards where Miles took off for another Longhorn score. He was lined up for the extra point when the snap went over the holders head. Miles caught it and found Popham alone in the end zone for the conversion, but there was another hanky on the ground. Miles lined up again for the extra point and participated in a play worthy of SportCenter's highlight reel. The kick was blocked by Anthony Anaya, sending the ball straight up in the air. Miles caught it and was surrounded by Polar Bears. He started going down, kept his balance and pitched the ball to Groce who took off around left end. When he was caught by the defense, he found Popham in the end zone for a bizarre 2-point conversion. Groce capped the next drive with a 23-yard run on second down. Miles made it 50-8.

Groce finished the scoring for the evening with a 13-yard run. The block extra point left it at 56-8. Axtell gave up 7 first downs and 80 total yards in offense for the evening. The Polar Bears managed 31 rushing yards in the first half and -11 in the second half for a total of 20 ground yards in the game.

Axtell is now 3-3 for the season and 1-1 in District play. They will travel to Italy this Friday.

ITALY — Sky Simon's three-yard touchdown run in the third overtime, period lifted the Gladiators to a District 16-2A win over the Longhorns.

The Gladiators (6-2. 2-0) led 14-7 heading into the final minute of regulation. But Axtell (6-2, 0-2) forced the overtime when Jacob Barrett hit Preston Finley on a 21-yard touchdown pass with 21 seconds left.

Scorpio Babers rushed for 113 yards on 10 carries for Italy. He scored on a 68-yard interception return, as well as a58-yard rush.
