Reicher 39, Axtell 2

(Axtell) – The Axtell Longhorns JV ran into a very tough Reicher ball club and wound up on the short end of a 39-2 game. Reicher used the ground game on the opening drive to start the scoring with a 41 yard run from their quarterback. A missed extra point left it at 6-0. After a stop on Axtell's opening drive, the Cougars were back in business, taking over at the Horn 35 yard line, after a miscue on the Longhorn punt. The Cougars took advantage of the mistake, scoring on a 15 yard pass to increase the lead to 12 points. This extra point was partially blocked and Jacob Kubitza returned the kick 104 yards for Axtell's only score of the evening.

Reicher continued to move the ball well against Axtell, driving 61 yards to increase the lead to 18-2. The score came on a 28 yard pass. The conversion pass was incomplete. Another Longhorn bobble, this time a short punt, set the Cougs up in Longhorns territory. A 43-yard scamper buried the Horns even deeper and the PAT made it 25-2.

Another short punt on the opening Longhorn drive left Reicher setting at the Horns 23-yard line. A six yard and seventeen yard run made it 31-2. Again the extra point was true. Axtell drove to the Cougar thirty before giving the ball back to Reicher on downs. Axtell held but an interception gave the ball back to the Cougars who drove into Longhorn territory before losing the ball on downs. Reicher returned a Longhorn punt to the 34-yard line of Axtell. A 32-yard run and extra point closed out the scoring for the evening. When the final Longhorn drive stalled, the Cougars were content to run out the clock.

Just judging by the score, you might think that the Horns offense was stuffed all evening long, but they were able to move the ball against the Cougars. The Reicher defense came up with big plays to stop drives and coupled with Longhorn miscues conspired to keep the Horns out of the end zone.

Axtell 49, hubbard 20

(Axtell) – One thing a football coach will worry about is how his team will come out after an open week. He wonders if they will respond or come out flat, especially when they are facing a team that they will be favored to beat handily. Coach Cadell only had to wait 13 seconds to get his answer against the Hubbard Jaguars. Kyle Voss took the opening kickoff back 85 yards for a touchdown and the Axtell Longhorns never looked back. The defense held Hubbard to –3 yards rushing in the opening quarter while the offense scored at will to take control of the game.

After stopping Hubbard's opening drive, Weston Popham found Porter Miles for a 50 yard strike and a 14-0 lead. The defense send the Jags three and out and Axtell drove in for another score, this one on a one-yard run by Hunter Cadell and a 22-0 lead. The defense stuffed the Jaguars again and it appeared that Axtell may be looking for another first quarter score. But an errant pass that was picked off by Hubbard ended the drive. It also gave the Hubbard offense a spark and they were able to convert their first 1st down of the game.

Hubbard took that drive down to the Longhorn fifteen yard line before turning it over on downs. Another interception stopped the Horns drive and again the defense forced a punt. Axtell took over at their own 45-yard line and got the offense back into gear, culminating with a 16 yard touchdown catch by Taylor Dunlap to put Axtell up by 30 with four and a half minutes left in the half. Hubbard found a running game on their next possession and marched 64 yards to cut into the Longhorn lead. The Jaguar score was on a 20 yard run by Darnell Lang. The 2-point conversion failed and Axtell was up 30-6. Axtell began driving but coughed up the ball and the Jaguars pounced on it. With time running out, the Jaguars tried a desperation pass toward the end zone. A pair of Longhorn defenders converged and knocked the ball into the air where the Hubbard's Lance McClain accepted the gift and walked into the end zone for the touchdown. This time the conversion for two was true and the Horns led at halftime, 30-14.

After stopping the Jaguar's opening drive. Axtell drove 65 yards in eleven plays, with Popham keeping it for the score and a 36-14 lead. Axtell again forced the Jags to punt and the offense was off and running (and passing) again. But the drive died on the Hubbard 1 yard line when the ball wiggled loose from the Horns again. The Jaguar offense which had been stymied all night long, put together the best drive of the game, going 99 yards and ending with a 66 yard reception by McClain. It appeared that the Jaguars might make a game of it until Charlie Groce took the kickoff from his own 30 yard line to the Jags 25 yard line. Randy Smith punched it in from the nine yard line and Miles added the extra point. Hubbard attempted to close the gap and had a nice drive going until Groce stepped in front of a pass and raced 63 yards to put the icing on the cake. Miles extra point was wide and the Horns made the score 49-20. Hubbard was then content to run out the clock and get out of Longhornland.

Axtell is sitting in good shape for the playoffs this year. There are still several scenerios that can play out before this thing is over but if the Horns win out, they will go into the large school division of the state playoffs.

AXTELL (SPL) - The Axtell Longhorns and Wortham Bulldogs strugg1ed to a 0-0 standoff here Friday night in their Districk 10-B battle.

Axtell got the closest penetration of the night when it drove to the Wortham 10 in the third period but fumbled on second down and lost possession.

Leonard McLennan and Gerald Tieris led the Axtell defense with McLennan getting 12 tackles and blocking a punt.

Stanley Chatman triggered the Wortham offense while Malcolm Brooks and Tom Gordons paced the Bulldog defense.

Wortham had 15 first downs a whopping 221 yards rushing but could never penetrate the tough Axtell goal line. Axtell had 10 first downs and 129 yards rushing.

This game served as a preview for the Axtell-Wortham tilt a season later when a district title was on the line. Axtell and Wortham tied that game also, but Wortham won the coin toss and the right to advance into the playoffs.


