- Eliminated the historic trial backlog at the York County Probate Court, while issuing speedy, thoughtful decisions.
- Doubled the amount of available trial time in the York County Probate Court so that parties can obtain speedy resolution.
- Introduced a “rocket docket” trailing trial list applauded by attorneys and others, making our Probate Court among the speediest and most responsive of Maine’s courts.
- Pioneered the introduction of child support for guardians of children in Maine, so that they will receive financial help from children’s parents according to ability to pay.
- Revised Maine’s court forms to enable physicians to provide better information about incapacitated persons, so that maximum liberty and dignity can be promoted.
- Authored the acclaimed article “Maine’s Probate Courts: The Other Family Law” in the Maine Bar Journal (2003).
- Selected by the Maine Department of Human Services to produce and appear throughout a video on Adult Guardianships and Conservatorships which was played in all of Maine’s 16 probate courts for the benefit of potential guardians and conservators.
