

New Mexico Resident Registration

Registration is required for OHVs prior to using on any PUBLIC LANDs in New Mexico

Vehicles that are considered to be OHVs & must be registered including:

- All-terrain vehicles (ATVs)
- Dirt bikes
- Off-road vehicles (ORVs, UTVs or Mule type vehicles)
- Snowmobiles

REGISTRATION AND FEES:

New Mexico residents are required to register their OHV at any Motor Vehicle Division Field Officer

\$53 for initial registration - \$50 thereafter

OHVs must be renewed every two years - if used on public lands

Out of State Visitor Permitting

Non-resident permitting is required for OHVs prior to using on any PUBLIC LANDs in New Mexico

- All-terrain vehicles (ATVs)
- Dirt bikes
- Off-road vehicles (ORVs, UTVs or Mule type vehicles)
- Snowmobiles
