
COMES NOW Norm Maleng, Prosecuting Attorney in the name and by the authority of the State of Washington, by and through Jennifer L. Worley, Deputy Prosecuting Attorney, and respectfully moves this court to strike the above-referenced hearing and pleadings.

As this court is aware, the State informed Mr. Knight of its intention to move to dismiss the underlying DWLS 3 charge on Thursday, June 17, 2004 (jury trial date) and requested that Mr. Knight strike the hearing set for Wednesday, June 16, 2004 in the Honorable Judge Doerty's court. Mr. Knight refuses to do so.

1 The State has now filed a written motion with Seattle District Court, signed by the court,
2 dismissing Mr. Knight's underlying DWLS 3 charge, without prejudice. Attached as Appendix
3 A. Thus, the prior stated intentions of the State have now been fulfilled.

4 In the interests of judicial economy the State moves to strike Mr. Knight's Application
5 for a Writ of Prohibition and strike the hearing set for Wednesday, June 16, 2004. In there now
6 clear, and have been fulfilled.
