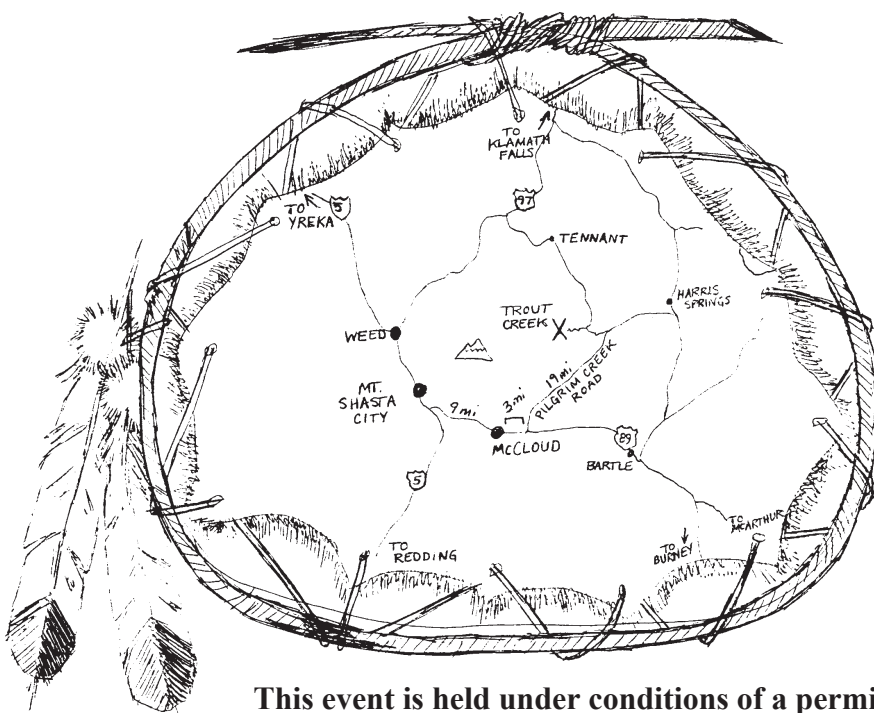

SAFETY RULES AND CAMP REGULATIONS

- No loaded firearms In camp.** Firearms to be loaded and capped or primed, only on the firing line and only When the range is opened by the Rangemaster. All firearms to be kept pointed in the air until you are ready to shoot at the designated target.
- No loading directly from powder horn, flask, can or other container. **Use a powder measure.**
- No alcoholic beverages or smoking on the firing line.
- Shooting glasses and ear plugs are encouraged.
- Juniors and pee wees must have adult supervision.
- Patched round ball only. Open Iron sights. Traditional guns only.
- Illicit drugs and narcotics strictly prohibited.
- Camping restricted to designated areas. Camps must be 50 feet from creek. This is a Forest Service campground, so please help us keep It clean.
- Dogs and other pets to be kept on leash and under control at all times.
- Minor children must be under Parent or guardian supervision at all times.
- Quiet camp after midnight.
- No motorcycles, ATV'S or other disruptive activity In camp.
- Fire permits are required.
- This Is a family sport. It Is expected that appropriate conduct will be demonstrated with due regard for all others. Rowdiness, lewd conduct and discharging of firearms in camp will not be tolerated. Offenders will be disqualified and asked to leave Immediately.
- Trader Guild Rules will apply to all trade goods. In lieu of USFS permit, traders are responsible for 3% of sales. This will be collected by MSLR and remitted to USFS.
- The Rangemaster will have complete authority over the range and camp area. Any violation of the rules will justify shooter disqualification.
- Mt. Shasta Longrifles Black Powder Club reserves the right to refuse entry to anyone.
- Mt. Shasta Longrifles ask that all participants assist us in monitoring unsafe conditions or unsafe acts by anyone. We want no injuries from any cause to mar the enjoyment of our sport. Any questions, problems or complaints, please let us know. Safety is the concern and responsibility **OF EVERYONE.**
