What are Feed Readers?

- Feed Readers are Internet programs used to retrieve the latest news about some subject of interest.
- Some of the Programs are free.
- For our discussion we will use the Atilon program.
 - Examples of news subjects are:
 - National News.
 - Computer news
 - Environmental News

- The Abilon Reader is a free portable program.
- Features
 - Install Groups by right clicking the group
 - Install feeds by right clicking the group.
 - Update Feeds with F5 or right click
- Personally I use “Active Web Reader”

 - Free program, very user friendly.

- Open up your favorite reader or open up the Abilon reader. (Feeds are updated when the program is started)
 - Click a item on the Feeds Tree
 - Click on a Feed item from the Feeds List
 - Click on a news item for more detail.
 - In the Ablion reader you will then be sent to a web-page for the news details.
 - Some readers will open up a page in the reader itself.
