Rotary is open to all persons from the age of twenty onwards. Rotary is colour and gender blind and is looking for open-minded caring people to join. Why join Rotary? Here are some of the reasons.

#### **Friendship:**

In an increasingly complex world, Rotary provides one of the most basic human needs: the need for friendship and fellowship. It is one of the two reasons why Rotary began in 1905.

#### **Personal Growth and Development:**

Membership in Rotary continues one's growth and education in human relations and personal development.

#### **Leadership Development:**

Rotary is an organization of leaders and successful people.

#### **Citizenship in the Community:**

Membership in a Rotary club makes one a better community citizen. The average Rotary club consists of the most active citizens of any community.

#### **Continuing Education:**

Each week at Rotary there is a programme designed to keep one informed about what is going on in the community, nation, and world. Each meeting provides an opportunity to listen to different speakers talking about a variety of interesting topics.

#### **Fun:**

Rotary is fun, a lot of fun. Each meeting is fun. The club projects are fun. Social activities are fun. The service is fun.

#### **Citizenship in the World:**

Every Rotarian wears a pin that says "Rotary International". There are few places on the globe that do not have a Rotary club. Every Rotarian is welcome, even encouraged, to attend any of the 31,000 clubs in

Rotarians practise a 4-Way Test that governs one's ethical standards both at home and in the workplace. Rotarians are expected to be ethical in business and personal relationships.

- 1.) Is it the **Truth**? 2.) Is it **Fair** to all concerned?
- 3.) Will it build **Goodwill** and **Better Friendships**?
- 4.) Will it be **Beneficial** to all concerned?

#### **The Opportunity to Serve:**

Rotary is a service club. Its business is mankind. Its product is service. Rotarians provide community service to both local and international communities. This is perhaps the best reason for becoming a Rotarian: the chance to do something for somebody else; to sense the self-fulfilment that comes in the process. It is richly rewarding.
