

Paramount Roulette System

The world's most coveted
roulette strategy!

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The Original Paramount Roulette System

This system was designed to be used on the outside wheel, betting only on the dozens.

The table is divided into three dozens: from one to twelve, thirteen to twenty-four and twenty-five to thirty-six. I am going to refer to them from this point on as the first section (1-12), second section (13-24) and third section (25-36). This system ignores the existence of the zero or zeros.

The amount that you begin with (your bankroll) and your average bet is irrelevant to the success of this system. However, there is a bankroll formula which I recommend in order to maximize your winning potential. Please refer to the section entitled "Bankroll Formula," found later in this book.

Before you place your first bet, you must wait for a hit within the first section. The chance of it falling within the first section is theoretically 33%. But, if you watch for a while you will begin to notice that it hits within the first section much less than it theoretically should.

Once it hits within the first section, be prepared to place your first bet.

Place two bets down. Place one bet in the second section and place one bet in the third section. The objective of this strategy is to cover 66% of the numbers (excluding the zero or zeros). The odds in these sections are 2 to 1. Therefore, if it hits anywhere between 13 and 36, you win and will collect one extra unit than what you laid down.

Following your first win, I suggest you repeat the same bet only two more consecutive times. After the third hit within the second or third section the likelihood of a hit in the first section is much greater.

At this point, just sit back and wait till the next time it hits in the first

section. Then simply repeat the process again.

An alternative to waiting that I often employ is to move to another table and watch for a hit in the first section. Then deploy this powerful system again! *Caution!* If you utilize this method, make sure you are using casino chips and not roulette chips (a/k/a colors). If you leave the table with roulette chips they become worthless because their values are variable and set by the individual tables.

If, however, you are very unfortunate and lose a game. Don't worry. It's very easy to catch up. At this point, you must immediately place another two bets down: one on the second section and one on the third. Don't forget the rule of the system: place your bets after it hits in the first section. The rule still applies if you were playing a particular game and it hits in the first section subsequently causing you to lose.

I suggest that you play again only one other time after a loss. If the first section comes up twice in a row, it's time to take a break and let the first section streak wear itself out before continuing play. This reduces your chances of suffering losses which will take a considerable amount of wins in order to recover from.

It is one thing to have access to and knowledge of a powerful, winning system like mine. However, you must still exercise a certain amount of sound judgment and common sense when playing roulette.

The Advanced Paramount Roulette System [Beta Release Version]

This advanced version of The Paramount Roulette System enables you to win up to four times as many units while wagering the same number of units as the original Paramount Roulette System.

This is what I call an active method, meaning it's not a static system. The bets are placed in different spots for each new spin of the wheel. This is a more exciting system to play because you have to

pay more attention to the action than with the original version of The Paramount Roulette System.

This system utilizes the outside bets again to maximize the return on your investment. However, instead of only using the second and third dozens or sections, we'll be using all three sections as well as all three columns at the end of the table.

For the purposes of this system, the sections will remain the same as before. Section one represents numbers one through twelve. Section two represents numbers thirteen through twenty-four. Section three represents numbers twenty-five through thirty-six.

Column one represents the section headed by the number one and ending with number thirty-four. Column two represents the section headed by the number two and ending with number thirty-five. Column three represents the section headed by the number three and ending with number thirty-six.

There is a very short waiting period involved with this system. You just have to wait for one spin of the wheel to occur to establish your betting position. After that, you may immediately place your first bet.

You will be placing your bet in the corresponding section and column where the ball last landed. For example, if the ball landed on number twenty-five, then you will place one unit on section three and one unit on column one. With this bet in place, you are now covering the following numbers:

In Column one: 1, 4, 7, 10, 13, 16, 19, 22, 25, 28, 31 and 34

In Section three: 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35 and 36

If the ball lands in any one of these twenty-four spots, you will win one unit.

However, if you will notice, there is an overlap of four numbers: 25, 28, 31 and 34.

If the ball lands in any one of those four spots, you will gain four units!

After every spin of the wheel, continue playing in this fashion, following the section and column where the ball lands last.

The Paramount Baccarat System [Beta Release Version]

In baccarat there are only three possible bets you can make. They are the bank bet, player bet or the tie bet. The bank and player bets both pay one for one, or even money. The tie bet pays at eight to one.

The generally accepted figures for the house advantage in baccarat are 1.16% for the bank hand and 1.37% for the player hand. Therefore, the bank bet is the more profitable of the two. Albeit, there is a 5% commission on all bank bet winnings. The tie bet should not even be given consideration.

Before you even take a seat at the baccarat table, you should watch the table for a few minutes. You should be looking for two things:

1. Which of the two hands is winning more often, whether it's the bank hand or the player hand.
2. Which player is winning the most hands.

These will be the two key pieces of information that you'll be utilizing when you finally sit down at the table.

In baccarat, a unique playing situation exists which can't be found in many other casino games: the ability to emulate your fellow players' bet without being accused of doing so. You can follow another winning player's bets in roulette, but they will quickly notice what you are doing and get annoyed with you. However, in baccarat, it is a common practice.

When you get a seat at the table, follow the bets of the winning player whom you've been tracking. Watch what all the other players at the table are doing: most will wait for the winning player to place his bet before they place theirs! It is not uncommon to see all the players at a baccarat table have their bets placed on either banker or player simultaneously.

The only bets in which I won't follow someone into are the tie bets. They simply aren't worth the risk.

If the player whom I am emulating places a tie bet, then I place a bet on either banker or player, depending on which bet is more dominant in the current shoe. If the shoe is choppy, meaning neither of the two bets is dominant, then I will place a bet on banker because the house advantage is lower on that bet. This is where your earlier observations will come in handy.

In conjunction with the above method of determining where to place your bets, I recommend using a progression to gain quick profits. I will demonstrate the pattern of this progression with the following example:

Let's suppose you are using black chips or \$100 units. You place a chip on bank and win. You win \$100, minus your 5% commission. Keep those two units on the table. Bank wins again and you're up to \$400. Keep your chips on the table. Bank wins again and you're up to \$800. Keep your chips on the table. Bank wins again and you're up to \$1600! At this point it is up to you whether to withdraw your chips from play or not.

If you don't withdraw your chips from play and you lose the next hand, you didn't lose \$1600. You only lost the initial \$100 that you wagered. If, however, you win the next hand, you are up to \$3200 based on five wins with a \$100 bet!

If you do lose or withdraw your chips from play, you can start the progression over again by placing another \$100 wager.

The Bankroll Formula

The Bankroll Formula which I have devised is formulated to work best in conjunction with The Paramount Roulette System and its derivatives. It is a simple formula but it is designed to ensure that you reach your maximum winning potential.

The formula requires you to carry a bankroll equivalent to twenty full plays using The Paramount Roulette System. Each full play consists of placing two units, one in the first section and one in the second section. Please refer to the previous pages for full details.

If, for example, you would like to play with \$10 units, you would be placing \$20 down on each spin of the wheel. Therefore, you would require a bankroll of \$400.

$$\$Bet \times 2 \times 20 = Bankroll$$

With a bankroll of this size, you are guaranteed to never lose your bankroll. With the assistance of The Paramount Roulette System, you will never lose twenty consecutive spins of the wheel.

The Professional Solution

I have also received many requests from people who aspire to become professional roulette players. Therefore, I designed a business plan to guide them in the right direction. Again, my business plan is simple yet highly effective. If you accurately follow the instructions set forth, you should be able to retire and begin enjoying the rest of your life too!

I must forewarn you though. In order to earn a good income from

playing professional roulette, you should be prepared to utilize a decent-sized bankroll. Based on my Bankroll Formula, you should be using a minimum bankroll of \$4000. This isn't a large sum if you consider this to be a business investment as opposed to a recreational gambling fund. Think about it: how many small businesses can launch using only \$4000? Not many...

Furthermore, because of the low start-up costs involved and near zero overhead, your return-on-investment will be quite high. Plus, you will see a quick return on your investment.

The most important trait to possess as a professional gambler is self-control. Without self-control you are merely another run-of-the-mill gambler, which means you will most likely be a losing gambler.

You must set a daily limit of winnings for yourself. When you achieve your limit, then leave the casino. For example, let's say you want to win \$100 a day. I'll show you how you can do so very easily.

If you want to win \$100 a day, seven days a week, simply follow this program. This program can be adjusted for any amount. This program will produce a regular income of \$700 a week or \$36,400 a year! This is an above average income for most adults!

Play roulette daily with The Paramount Roulette System, using \$100 units. One win and you've reached your daily quota! That's it! For a few minutes a day, you're earning yourself a handsome full-time income!

The theory behind this is the fact that it's easier to win a little everyday than to win a lot all in one day.
