<p>From "A Genealogical Dictionary of the First Settlers of New England...", by James Savage, Vol. I, p. 54: JOHN, Farmington, one of the first sett. freem. 1658, by w. Mary had Mary, b. 15 Apr. 1643; John, 12 Aug. 1645; Hannah, 26 Feb. 1647, all bapt. 16 May 1658; Abraham, 31 Oct. 1648; Daniel, 1650; Joseph, 26 May 1651; there three bapt. 2 Apr. 1654; Rachel, bapt. 9 Apr. 1654; but why all were not bapt. at once, may be left to plausible conject. Stephen, b. 1606; and Benjamin, June 1659; and d. 1682. His wid d. May 1694. Of the ch. my knowl. is less complete; John, eldest s. was prob. of Hartford, and had John, Joseph, Stephen, and others, yet m. or b. dates are blank; Mary m. as sec. w. Thomas Barnes; Hannah m. Richards, prob. Obadiah; and Rachel m. a Buck.</p> <p>His will dated 9 Nov 1681 leaves to his wife Marie the use of the new end of his dwelling house and the seller under itt and the use of the frute of half his orchard. He gives to her the feather bedd and all its furnishings to dispose of as she wishes. He leaves to his son Benjamin the house, barn and homelott after Marie's death. His son John is left his lot that abutts on Hartford Bounds, His son Abraham is left a 20 acre lot in the Great Swamp. His son Daniel is left 2 acres of meadow land and the upland lott that is next to the one in the swamp. Joseph is left his 40 acre Upland lot. Benjamin also gets the Upland lots that are not layd out yet. His swine and corn are left to Benjamin to pay some legacies. Grandchild Thomas Barns 20 shillings Grandchild John Andrews £1 Grandchild Abraham Andrews £1 Grandchild John Richards £1 Grandchild Daniel Andrews £1 Grandchild Ezekiel Buck £1 His grandchild Joseph Andrews is to have £15 and 2 suits of apparel if he remains with his grandmother Anne and uncle Benjamin until he is 21. If Joseph takes him away before that he gets nothing but won't have to pay for his keep. Daughter Marie Barns is to have his black heifer. Daughter Hannah Richards is to have two yearlings. Daughter Rachel Buck is to have his 2 year old red heifer.</p> <p>He was an early settler of Farmington.</p>
