At a Legall meeting of the Inhabitants of Suffield; Dec ye 131h, Anno Dommi : 1699...Tything Men-Ebenezer Smith, Benony Banes.  
p. 138:

At our Anniversary, or Generall Town meeting, March the 3d, Annoq Domini, 1701, for the choice of need-full officers, to order the affairs of a gennerall concernment for the welfare of this place; accordingly choice was made, and the persons chosen for the ensuing year are these, hereafter mentioned by name.

Att a Lawfull Town Meeting of the Inhabitants of Suffield, March ye, 22d, 1721, Voted 1st, that Ebenezer Smith should be Moderator for said Meeting...

p. 266:

March the 14th 1736/7. At an Annaversary meeting of the Freeholders and other Inhabitants of the Town of Suffield quallified to vote in Town affairs, to make choice of Necessary Town officers for the year Ensuing and other concerns of a Publick nature.-Samuel Kent ye 3d was chosen Moderator to manage said meeting.

Sixthly. Voted: that the ~~Y~~ Highway That Leads to Stony Brook by Ebenezer Smiths house shall be continued Where it was formerly Laid out and Recorded and be Improved accordingly: as soon as the present crop That is growing thereon be taken off.

~~Y~~ This road from the Kent Corners toward Taintor Hill was laid out in 1701, with bounds ill defined. John Kent Jr. lived where Julius Harmon's heirs now live. See p 140

p. 281:

Att a legal Town meeting of the Inhabitants of Suffield May the 19th 1740:

10ly. Also granted to Ebenezer Smith Twenty shillings and Ten pence in money for Druggs to Goodman Segar in his Sickness.

p. 283:

Att the Annaversary Town meeting of the Inhabitants of Suffield Quallified for voting in order to chose officers to chuse the prudential affairs of said Town and matters of General Concernment as the Law Directs. And accordingly choice was made as followeth - viz:-- March 1741...

Serveighers of highways-Ebenezer Smith, John Rising, John Burbank, David Smith, Samuel Rimington, Ruben Harmon, James Rising, Joseph Kent.

## General Notes (Wife)

James Barlow married Sarah Huxley on January 10, 1687/8, at Suffield [Vital Records of Granville, Massachusetts, To The Year 1850, N.E.H.G.S., 1914]. She was born in 1675 at Hartford, Connecticut, and was a daughter of Thomas and Sarah (Spencer) Huxley who had moved to Suffield from Hartford in 1678. After James' death she married second Ebenezer Smith around 1693 at Suffield. He was a son of Samuel and Mary (Ensign) Smith; died on September 15, 1728. Sarah married third Martin Kellogg of Suffield on October 5, 1732, at Suffield [Vital Records of Granville, Massachusetts, To The Year 1850, N.E.H.G.S., 1914]. Martin Kellogg was a son of Joseph and Joanna (Foote) Kellogg.
