

REFERENCES FORMAT ^{1,2}

References are identified in text, tables and legends by superscripts using Arabic numerals. References and journal title abbreviations are in the style adopted by the U.S. National Library of Medicine and used in *Index Medicus*. Examples are below:

STANDARD JOURNAL ARTICLE:

List all authors when three or less; when four or more, list only first three authors and add *et al.*:

Roberts LW, O'Donnell J, Matsuda T, *et al.* Pharmacy-assisted burn unit skin bank program. *Am J Hosp Pharm.* 1977;34:1353-4.

ARTICLE FROM JOURNAL PAGINATED BY ISSUE:

Goldschmidt L. Remodeling on a shoestring improves pharmacy's efficiency. *Hospitals.* 1979;53(May 1):115-6.
