FORMAT OF GONGYO

Morning:

- (1) **Ring the bell;**
- (2) Chant 3 Daimoku;
- (3) **Chant 3 Daimoku;**
- (4) Offer 1st Prayer;
- (5) **Chant 3 Daimoku;**

- (6) Ring the bell;
- (7) **Recite Part A;**
- (8) Ring the bell;
- (9) **Recite Part C;**
- (10) Chant Daimoku and ring the bell at start of Daimoku;
- (11) **Ring the bell to end Daimoku;**
- (12) Chant 3 Daimoku;
- (13) **Offer 2nd Prayer;**
- (14) Chant 3 Daimoku;
- (15) **Offer 3rd Prayer;**
- (16) Chant 3 Daimoku;
- (17) **Offer 4th Prayer with 3 Daimoku after sentence 2.**
- (18) Ring the bell after sentence 3;
- (19) **Chant 3 slow Daimoku.**

Evening: Same as Morning, except, SKIP 3, 4, and 5.

1st Silent Prayer: I offer appreciation to the functions in life and the environment (shoten zenjin) that serve to protect us and pray that these protective forces be further strengthened and enhanced through my practice of the law.

2nd Silent Prayer: I offer profound appreciation and pray to repay my debt of gratitude to the Dai- Gohonzon of the Three Great Secret Laws, which was bestowed upon the entire world; to Nichiren Daishonin, the Buddha of the Latter Day of the Law; and to Nikko Shonin. I offer

appreciation and pray to repay my debt of gratitude for Nichimoku Shonin.

3rd Silent Prayer: I pray that the great desire for kosen-rufu be fulfilled and that the Soka Gakkai International develop in this endeavor for countless generations to come. I offer appreciation and pray to repay my debt of gratitude for the three founding presidents-- Tsunesaburo Makiguchi, Josei Toda and Daisaku Ikeda--as eternal models of selfless dedication to the propagation of the Law.

4th Silent Prayer: I pray to bring forth Buddhahood from within my life, change my karma and fulfill my wishes in the present and the future. (*Offer additional prayers here.*)

I pray for my deceased relatives and for all those who have passed away, particularly for these individuals: (*Sound the bell continuously while offering prayers.*)

I pray for peace throughout the world and the happiness of all living beings.

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
