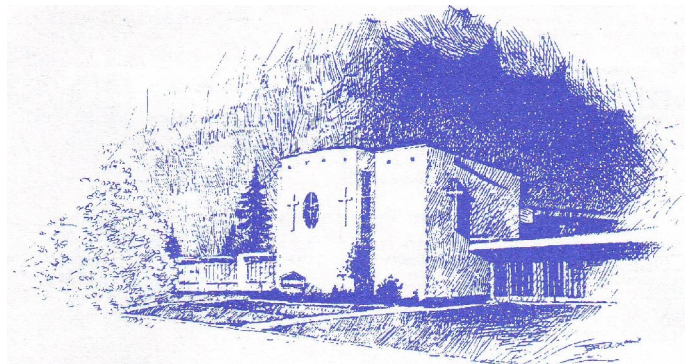

SUPREME COURT VIGIL

Social Justice is needed for today's Holy Innocents and hurting women in Canada, the only democratic nation where there is absolutely no law to protect the most vulnerable – the unborn. Loss of legal protection began with the weak law of 1969 and its varied interpretations. By 1988, the Supreme Court eradicated all legal protection, leaving Parliament to formulate a better law. We are still waiting! Statistics Canada has indicated that nearly 3 million abortions have occurred since 1969. No wonder that educational institutes are closing, workplaces are short of help, and pensions are threatened!

Everyone is invited to come join the ProLife Society outside the Prince George Courthouse on Saturday, January 26, from 1:00 to 2:00 p.m. for a prayerful vigil petitioning for a law to protect the unborn.

There are two types of bursaries:

Madeleine d'Houet: for any Roman Catholic laywoman enrolled in full time theology or religious education in a recognized degree granting Canadian Catholic School of Theology (\$1000).

Short Courses: in Theology, Liturgy, Spirituality, Social Justice, Earth/Native Spirituality or Youth Ministry (no one bursary being more than \$500). A short course is of at least 10 academic days duration in a recognized Catholic school, institution or setting for formation.
