INFANT BAPTISM PREPARATION

When parents ask to have their children baptized, they are accepting the responsibility of training their children in the faith, of helping them to know God and to live as disciples of Jesus Christ within the community of the Church. The Church places such importance on the sacrament of Baptism, the first sacrament of initiation, that parents are required to take a preparation program before their children are baptized. At St. Mary's our program consists of two evenings of about 1 1/2 hours, where we explore the meaning of baptism and the responsibilities of the parents, godparents and community.
