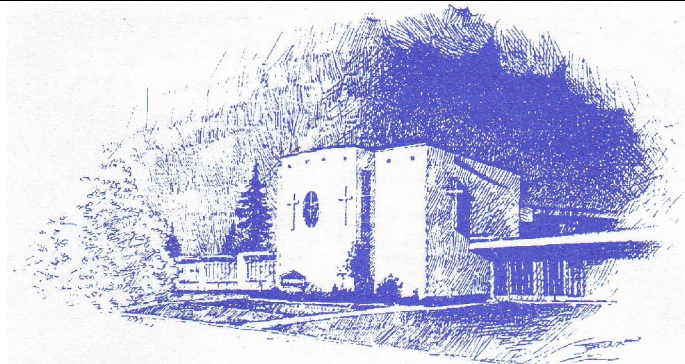

BAPTISM PREPARATION FOR INFANTS
