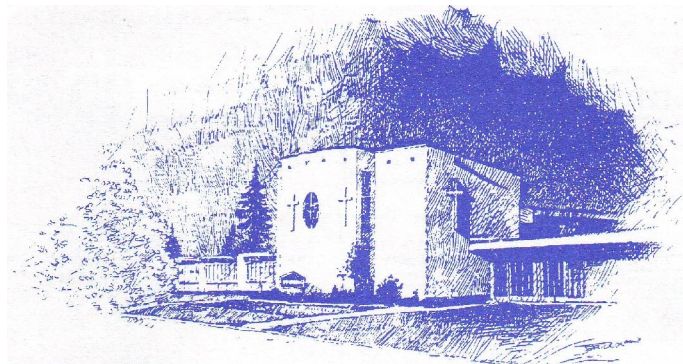

## SACRAMENTS
