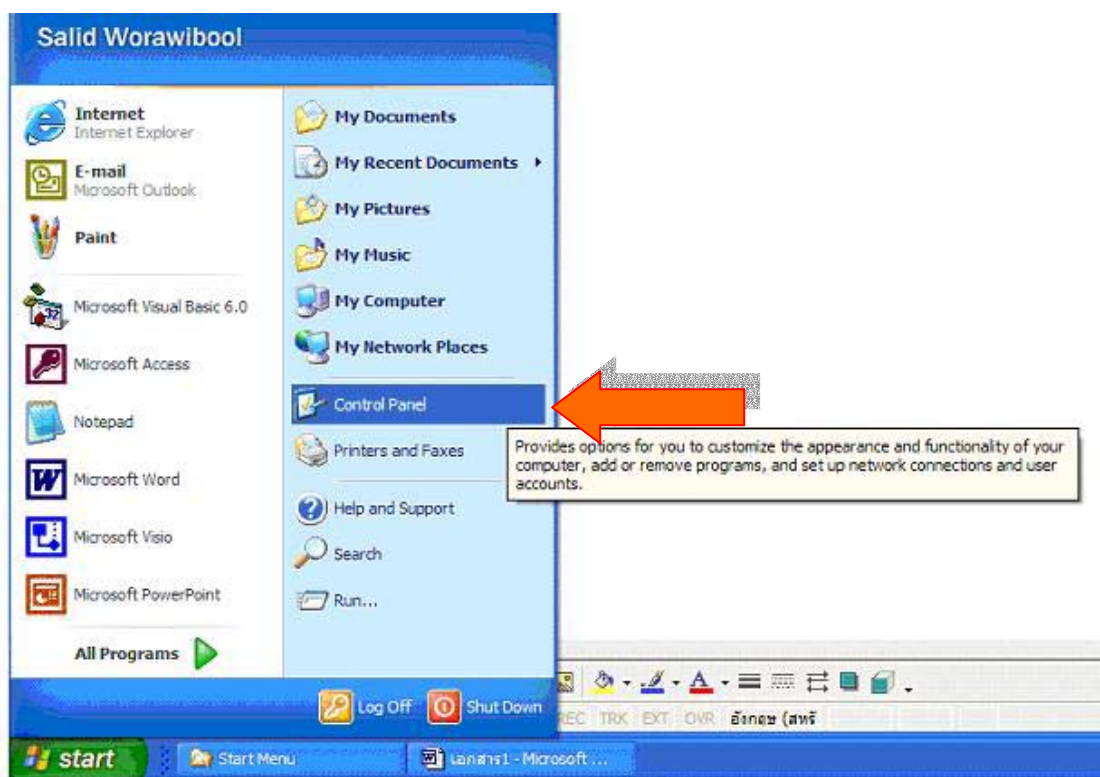


How to set up and use Chinese fonts on Windows XP?

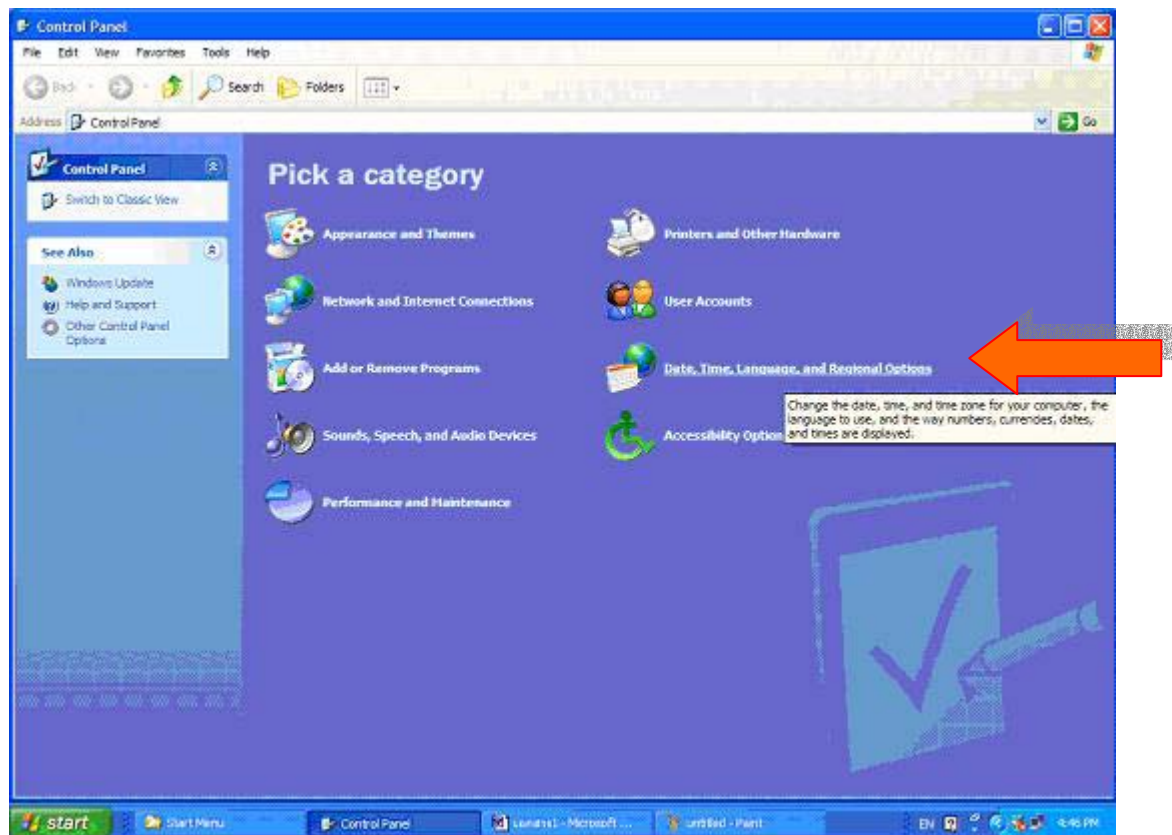
To Tan,

In case of use Window XP, when you try to set up Chinese language following to the below instructions, it won't ask for the CD of Windows XP, not like that of Windows 2000.

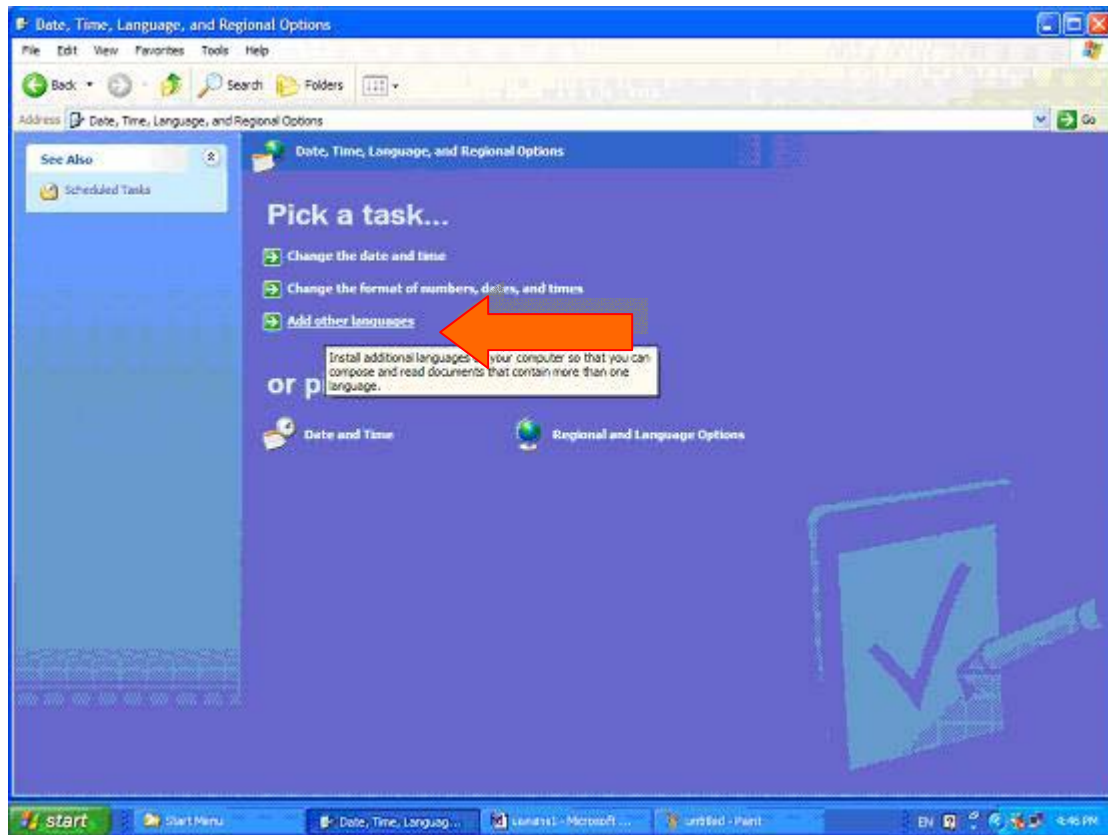
- 1) Click on “*Control Panel*” menu on the Start Menu.



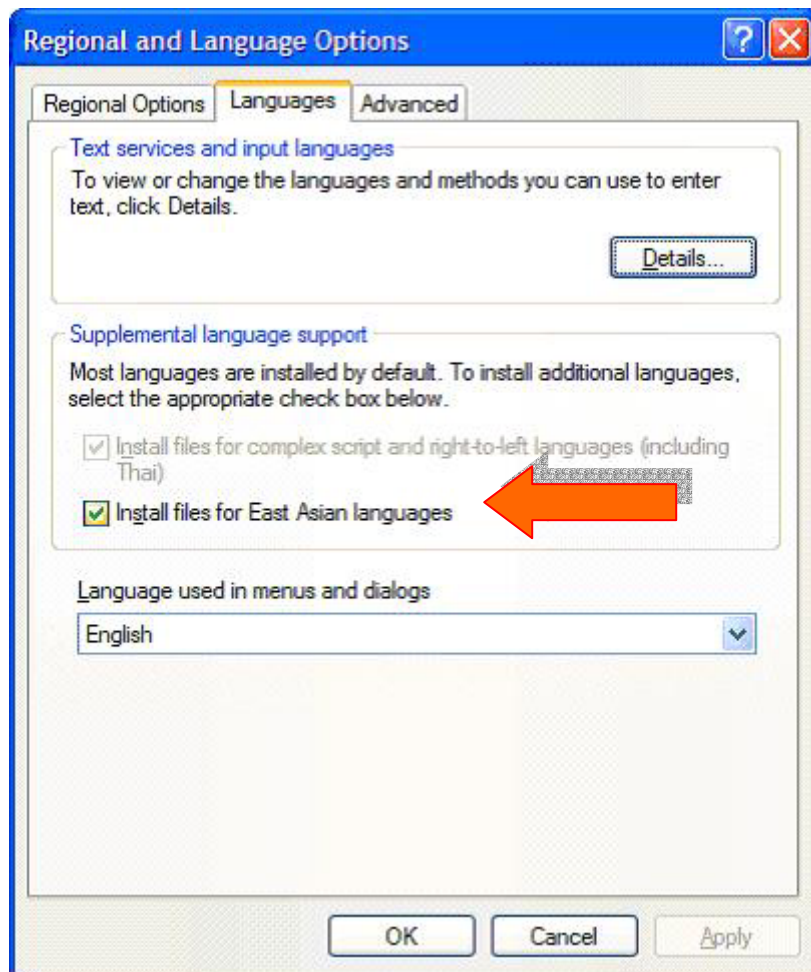
2) Click on “*Date, Time, Language and Regional options*” command.



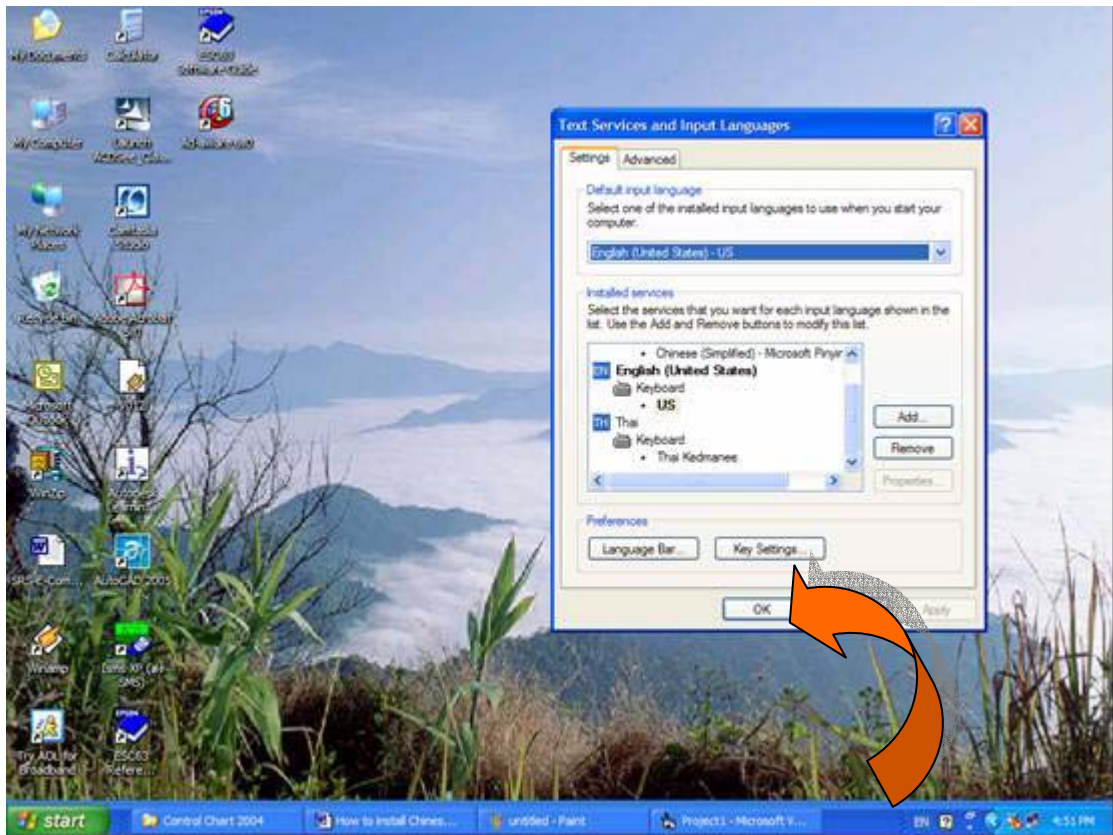
3) Click on “*Add other languages*” command.



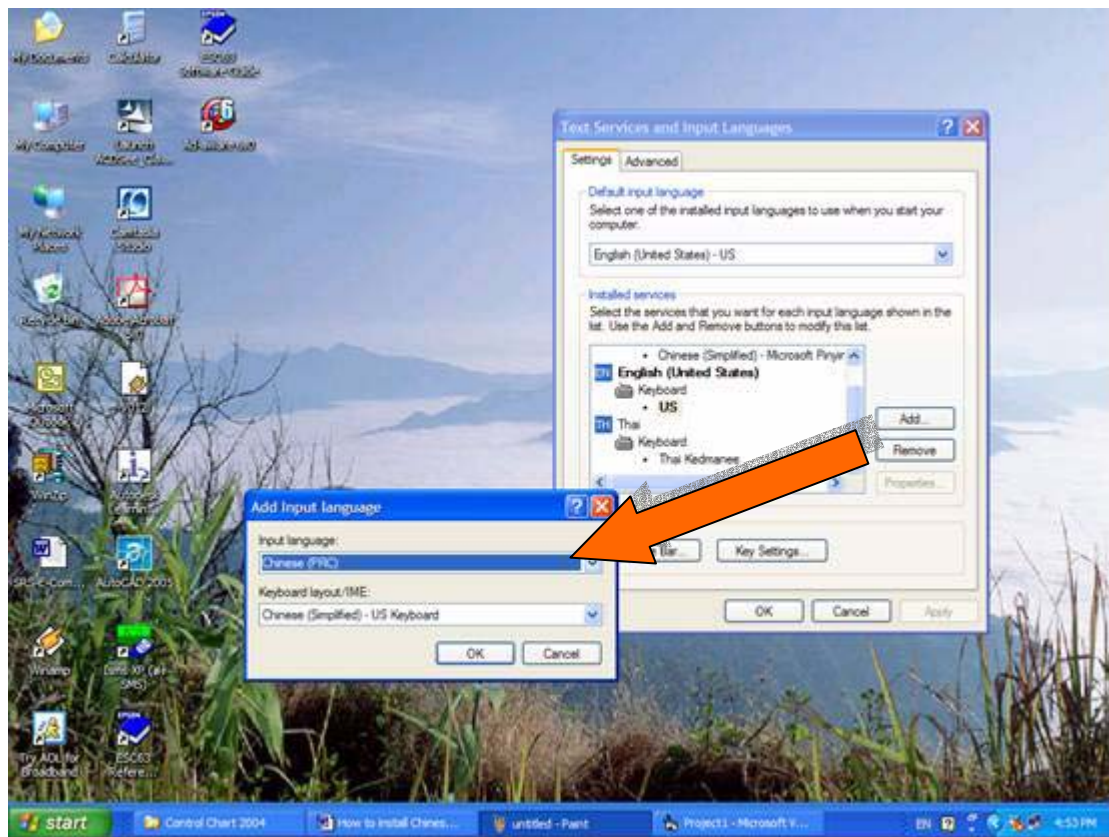
- 4) Do "Check" on "*Install Files for East Asian Languages*" command.



5) [Right click](#) on language setting on Task Bar.



6) Click on “[Add...](#)” button to add new language.



7) And then on “[Add Input Language](#)” window. Select “[Chinese \(PRC\)](#)” item for input language data and then select “[Chinese \(Simplified-US Keyboard\)](#)” for the type of your keyboard input device.

Note : - PRC = People’s Republic of China, as there are many countries using Chinese language in the world such as Chinese-Hongkong,Chinese-Singapore,Chinese-Korea. Therefore, we need to specify that we shall use Chinese-PRC,not any others.
