**BAPTISMS** - PLEASE PICK UP A COPY OF OUR REQUIREMENTS AND GUIDELINES AT THE PARISH OFFICE OR VISIT OUR WEBSITE FOR INFORMATION REGARDING REQUIREMENTS AND SCHEDULES. SPONSORS (GOD-PARENTS) MUST BE PRACTICING CATHOLICS; 16 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER; BAPTIZED AND CONFIRMED CATHOLIC; AND, IF MARRIED, MUST BE MARRIED BY THE CATHOLIC CHURCH.

**QUINCEAÑERAS** - YOU MUST BE PREPARING TO RECEIVE THE SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION AND BE REGISTERED IN A CCD PROGRAM. IF ATTENDING OR TRANSFERRING FROM ANOTHER PARISH, MUST SHOW PROOF THAT YOU ARE ATTENDING A CCD PROGRAM. YOU MUST HAVE COMPLETED 25 COMMUNITY SERVICE HOURS. PLEASE CALL THE PARISH OFFICE FOR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION.

**MARRIAGES:** THE PARISH OFFICE MUST BE CONTACTED AT LEAST SIX (6) MONTHS IN ADVANCE OF THE DATE YOU'VE CHOSEN.

⇒ NON-CATHOLICS ARE WELCOME TO USE THE MISSION CHURCH FOR A WEDDING (RESTRICTIONS DO APPLY, PLEASE CALL THE PARISH OFFICE FOR ELIGIBILITY AND AVAILABILITY.)

⇒ NON-CATHOLIC CEREMONIES/MINISTERS NEED APPROVAL OF THE PASTOR.

⇒ JUSTICE OF THE PEACE CANNOT PERFORM WEDDINGS IN/OR AROUND THE MISSION CHURCH/COMPOUND.

## OCTOBER, MONTH OF THE ROSARY

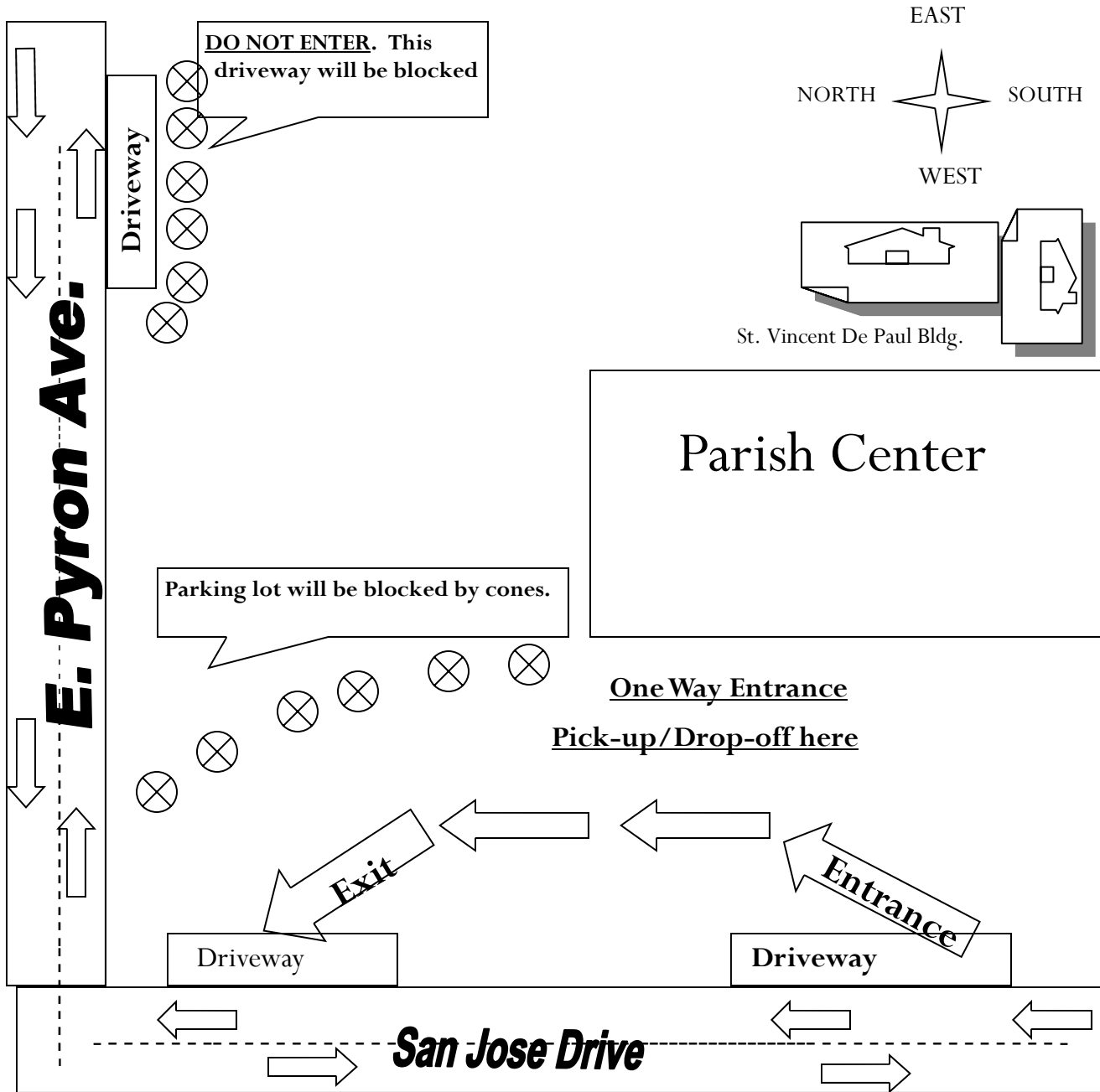
