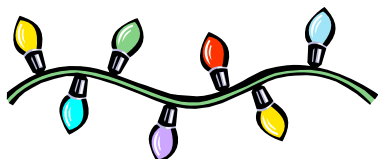

SOME CHRISTMAS RECIPES FROM LIZ!!

LIZ'S FAMILY FAVORITE TURKEY WITH GRAVY

This is a recipe that every poor cook, stuck in the kitchen all day, really deserves.

1 turkey (any size)!! Prepare as usual, but add 1 bottle of brandy prior to placing in oven at 375 C.

Every 15 minutes, pour one of the following over the bird:

- 1 bottle of rum (dark)
- 1 bottle of rum (light)
- 1 bottle of cognac
- 1 bottle of sherry (sweet)
- 1 bottle of sherry (dry)

Cook an additional 30 minutes, remove from oven, throw away the turkey and drink the gravy!!!

WHIPPED SHORTBREAD

These melt in your mouth. The secret is in the Beating!!

- 1 cup Butter
- 1½ cups Flour
- ½ cup Icing Sugar

Add a couple of drops of Almond Flavoring

Combine all ingredients & beat for 10 minutes.

Drop from teaspoon onto cookie sheet. Decorate with maraschino cherry pieces.

Bake at 350 for approx. 17 minutes until bottoms are lightly browned.

Makes approx. 3 dozen small cookies.

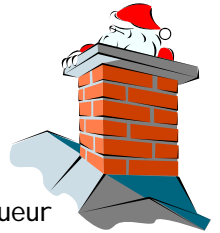


CHRISTMAS RECIPES CONTINUED!!

KAHLUA MOUSSE

- 2 eggs
- 1/4 cup of sugar
- 4 tbs of Kahlua or other Coffee Liqueur
- 3 oz. chocolate
- 1/4 cup butter
- 1 cup whipped cream
- Chocolate sticks

Mix all ingredients together.
Refrigerate 2 hours.



GALAXY BARS

(Liz's Daughter Jen's Recipe mmmmmmm!)

- ½ cup Butter
- 4 Mars Bars
- 2½ cups Rice Krispies
- 2½ cups Chocolate Dipping Wafers
(in bulk section at Co-op or Superstore)
- "Amount depends on how much you like chocolate!"

Melt Mars Bars and butter together over low heat, do not boil.

Add Rice Krispies and press into a cake pan.

Melt chocolate wafers in microwave and spread over squares.

Let squares set in fridge until chocolate is shiny.
