



**UNITED SYNAGOGUE YOUTH**  
**Southwest Regional Activities Code**

The SWUSY Regional Activities Code has been composed by the Southwest Region Youth Commission with the objective of providing assurance that every individual, every chapter, every congregation involved, the Southwest Region, and International USY will drive maximum benefit from every activity and create a safe and positive atmosphere for all participants. The rules are simple and provide for uniform conduct of high standard that govern the action of every person and group. Violations will result in disciplinary action that could include the USY'er being sent home at their parents' expense and/or suspension from USY activities.

1. No smoking is permitted.
2. No gambling of any kind is permitted.
3. No alcohol, weapons, or drugs are permitted.
4. *Kashrut* and *Shabbat* will be observed in accordance with the practices of the Conservative movement during and en route to and from USY activities.
5. *Tallit*, *t'fillin*, and *kippot* shall be worn as is appropriate during chapter and regional events.
6. No USY'er will leave the area of the event without the permission of the advisor or Regional Youth Director.
7. No USY'er shall violate any civil or criminal law, or violate another person's physical or mental integrity. Inappropriate or unwelcome physical contact or language shall not be permitted.
8. Each USY'er will cooperate with all adult advisors and shomrim.

Dues for SAUSY are \$<sup>30</sup>~~30~~, payable at the time of application for membership, and include per capita dues for South West Region and International USY. Make check payable to SAUSY and return completed application and dues to synagogue office.

I affirm that I am Jewish according to the *halachic* guidelines of the Conservative Movement and that I will abide by SAUSY Chapter rules and the SWUSY Regional Activities Code.
