Lynch, Michael—Captain July 17, 1861. Wounded at Chancellorsville, Va. May 3, 1863. Elected Major Apr. 18, 1864. Retired Nov. 18, 1864. (Appears as Major of the 77th Regt. Ga. Militia Feb. 14, 1861. No later record in this regiment.) (Born in 1835.)

Walton, Robert W.—1st Lieutenant July 17, 1861. Resigned May 21, 1862.

Johnston, Cornelius S. (or Johnson)—2d Lieutenant July 17, 1861. Resigned Nov. 28, 1861. Enlisted as a private in Co. G, 46th Regt. Ga. Inf. Mar. 4, 1862. Elected Jr. 2d Lieutenant Aug. 5, 1862. Appears last on roll for June 30, 1863.

Warren, Walter J.—Jr. 2d Lieutenant July 17, 1861. Elected 2d Lieutenant Nov. 28, 1861. Wounded at 2d Manassas, Va. Aug. 28, 1862. Elected 1st Lieutenant Nov. 1, 1862. Killed at Cold Harbor, Va. June 2, 1864.

Kenyon, John P.—1st Sergeant July 17, 1861. Roll for Aug. 31, 1864, last on file, shows he was dropped from rolls, "Supposed to be dead, Mar. 1, 1864."

May, Joseph W.—2d Sergeant July 17, 1861. Elected Jr. 2d Lieutenant Dec. 17, 1861. Wounded at 2d Manassas, Va. Aug. 28, 1862. Elected 2d Lieutenant Dec. 17, 1862. Wounded and disabled at Plymouth, N. C. Apr. 18, 1864. Roll for Aug. 31, 1864, last on file, shows him absent with leave. No later record.

McMickle, James M.—3d Sergeant July 17, 1861. Died of disease at Richmond, Va. June 5, 1862.

May, Benjamin W.—4th Sergeant July 17, 1861. Wounded at 2d Manassas, Va. Aug. 28, 1862. Killed at Cold Harbor, Va. May 30, 1864.

Dudney, John—1st Corporal July 17, 1861. Wounded at 2d Manassas, Va. Aug. 28, 1862. Appointed 2d Sergeant Dec. 17, 1862. Killed at Chancellorsville, Va. May 2, 1863.

Thomaston, James M.—2d Corporal July 17, 1861. Killed at Fredericksburg, Va. Dec. 13, 1862.

Adams, George W.—3d Corporal July 17, 1861. Appointed Sergeant Aug. 1, 1862. Killed at Chancellorsville, Va. May 2, 1863.

Richardson, Sydney J.—4th Corporal July 17, 1861. Appointed 1st Corporal Aug. 1, 1862. Killed at Plymouth, N. C. Apr. 18, 1864.

Stevens, James R. (or Stephens)—Musician July 17, 1861. Discharged, disability, at Sudley Church, near Centreville, Va. Oct. 7, 1861.

Abbott, William K.—Private Feb. 25, 1862. Appointed Hospital Steward. Captured at Fort Steadman, Va. Mar. 25, 1865. Released at Point Lookout, Md. May 13, 1865.

Adams, Caleb Charles—Private July 17, 1861. Discharged, disability, Sept. 1861. Enlisted as a private in Co. G, 46th Regt. Ga. Inf. May 6, 1862. Captured at Marietta, Ga. July 3, 1864. Paroled at Camp Morton, Ind. and sent to City Point, Va. for exchange, Feb. 28, 1865. No later record.

Argo, Richard—Private July 17, 1861. Wounded at Sharpsburg, Md. Sept. 17, 1862. Deserted. Received by Provost Marshal General, Washington, D. C., Apr. 4, 1865. Took oath of allegiance to U. S. Government and furnished transportation to Washington, D. C.

Atkinson, James A.—Private July 17, 1861. Died of typhoid fever at Sudley Church Hospital, near Centreville, Va., Nov. 21, 1861.
