

Banks, Governor H.—Private Sept. 9, 1861. Died in General Hospital at Charlottesville, Va. Apr. 27, 1862. Buried there in Confederate Cemetery.

Barnes, John—Private July 17, 1861. Discharged, disability, at camp near Centreville, Va. Oct. 7, 1861.

Bell, George W.—Private May 3, 1864. Captured at High Bridge, Va. Apr. 6, 1865. Released at Newport News, Va. June 26, 1865.

Bell, Jacob O.—Private Sept. 9, 1861. Appears last on roll for Apr. 30, 1863, with remark: "Absent, sick, Apr. 25, 1863." No later record.

Bell, Mathew L. (or Madison L.)—Private July 17, 1861. Wounded at Sharpsburg, Md. Sept. 17, 1862. Captured near Farmville, Va. Apr. 6, 1865. Paroled at Newport News, Va. June 26, 1865.

Bell, William G.—Private Feb. 20, 1862. Roll for Aug. 31, 1864, last on file, shows him present. Paroled, Albany, Ga. May 16, 1865.

Benton, James—Private July 17, 1861. Discharged, disability, Richmond, Va., Sept. 9, 1861.

Benton, John—Private July 17, 1861. Died of peritonitis at Camp E. K. Smith, near Centreville, Va., Dec. 13, 1861.

Boyett, Andrew J.—Private July 17, 1861. Appointed 4th Corporal Aug. 1, 1862; 5th Sergeant July 1, 1864. Surrendered, Appomattox, Va. Apr. 9, 1865.

Brooks, Allen B.—Private July 17, 1861. Discharged, disability, camp near Manassas, Va., Mar. 1, 1862.

Brown, George L.—Private Mar. 30, 1864. Captured at Hatcher's Run, Va. Feb. 6, 1865. Died at Point Lookout, Md. Apr. 7, 1865.

Brown, William L.—Private July 17, 1861. Wounded at Cold Harbor, Va. June 27, 1862. Wounded near Washington, D. C. July 1864. Died of wounds July 15, 1864. Buried at Arlington, Va.

Brown, William W.—Private Mar. 3, 1862. Admitted to General Hospital #18, at Richmond, Va. with measles, Apr. 24, 1862. Died of typhoid fever May 8, 1862.

Bullard, William—Private Oct. 24, 1863. Roll for Aug. 31, 1864, last on file, shows him absent without leave Mar. 1, 1864. No later record.

Burks, Charles R.—Private July 17, 1861. Discharged, disability, Oct. 1, 1861.

Burks, William J.—Private July 17, 1861. Appointed 2d Corporal Dec. 13, 1862. Pension records show he was wounded and captured at Monocacy, Md. July 10, 1864. Sent from Elmira, N. Y. to Point Lookout, Md. in 1864. Paroled at Fortress Monroe, Va. Nov. 1864. At home on wounded furlough close of war. (Born in Georgia in 1839.)

Bush, Marion—Private Feb. 27, 1862. Died at Richmond, Va. July 22, 1862. Buried there in Hollywood Cemetery.

Cahill, Thomas—Private July 17, 1861. Killed at Plymouth, N. C. Apr. 18, or 20, 1864.

Canady, James (or Canaday)—Private July 17, 1861. No later record.

Christian, Edmond (or Edward)—Private July 17, 1861. Wounded at 2d Manassas, Va. Aug. 28, 1862; Charlestown, W. Va. Aug. 21, 1864. Received pay at Columbus, Ga. Nov. 23, 1864. No later record.

Clarke, George W.—Private Mar. 4, 1862. Died of pneumonia in General Hospital #1, at Lynchburg, Va. May 2, 1862. Buried there in Confederate Cemetery. No. 2, 1st Line, Lot 166—Ferguson's Factory.

Clatt, Jesse F.—Private Feb. 25, 1862. Died at Culpeper, Va. Apr. 15, 1862.

Collins, Floyd—Private July 17, 1861. Admitted to General Hospital at Petersburg, Va. with dysentery Apr. 19, 1862. Returned to duty June 30, 1862. No later record.

Colson, Martin N. L.—Private Oct. 21, 1863. Absent with leave Aug. 1-31, 1863. No later record.
