

Hearn, John—Private July 17, 1861. Discharged, disability, at Richmond, Va. Oct. 28, 1862.

Hickson, Benjamin F.—Private July 17, 1861. Killed at Cold Harbor, Va. June 27, 1862.

Hines, Erasmus R.—Private July 17, 1861. Died at Richmond, Va. May 15, 1862. Buried there in Hollywood Cemetery.

Hobson, Edwin F.—Private July 17, 1861. Killed at Sharpsburg, Md. Sept. 17, 1862.

Hudson, W. N.—Private July 17, 1861. Died of chronic rheumatism in Pettigrew General Hospital #13, at Raleigh, N. C. Aug. 8, 1864. Buried there in Confederate Cemetery.

Hurt, James—Private Dec. 10, 1861. Admitted to Chimborazo Hospital #5, at Richmond, Va. with measles, Apr. 21, 1862. Discharged, disability, July 17, 1862.

Hurt, John A.—Private July 17, 1861. Appointed Corporal. Captured near Petersburg, Va. Mar. 25, 1865. Released at Point Lookout, Md. May 13, 1865.

Irwin, John F.—Private July 17, 1861. Appointed 1st Sergeant Dec. 18, 1861. Wounded at Cross Keys, Va. June 8, 1862; Cedar Run, Va. Aug. 9, 1862. Elected Jr. 2d Lieutenant Dec. 17, 1862; Captain Apr. 18, 1864. Captured at Sailor's Creek, Va. Apr. 6, 1865. Released at Johnson's Island O. June 18, 1865.

Johnson, Charles J.—Private July 17, 1861. Deserted. Received by Provost Marshal General at Washington, D. C., a Confederate deserter, Apr. 4, 1865. Took oath of allegiance to U. S. Govt. and furnished transportation to Philadelphia, Pa.

Johnson, Raleigh M.—Private Sept. 9, 1861. Roll for Aug. 31, 1864, last on file, shows him absent, "Division Pioneer Corps Apr. 7, 1863." No later record.

Jones, George W.—Private Sept. 9, 1861. Wounded at 2d Manassas, Va. Aug. 28, 1862. Killed in Valley of Virginia in 1864.

Jones, Jasper F.—Private Sept. 9, 1861. Died of typhoid fever at Sudley Church Hospital near Centreville, Va. Nov. 8, 1861.

Jones, William P.—Private Sept. 9, 1861. Wounded at 2d Manassas, Va. Aug. 28, 1862, and died there of wounds Aug. 29, 1862.

Kent, John W.—Private Oct. 9, 1863. Deserted. Received by Provost Marshal General, Washington, D. C., a Confederate deserter, Apr. 4, 1865. Took oath of allegiance to U. S. Govt. and furnished transportation to Savannah, Ga.

Kent, Josiah M.—Private Sept. 28, 1863. Killed, Drewry's Bluff, Va., May 16, 1864.

Kenyon, Allen—Private Feb. 25, 1862. Roll for Aug. 31, 1864, last on file, shows him present. No later record.

Kenyon, Harrison—Private Feb. 25, 1862. Killed at 2d Manassas, Va. Aug. 28, 1862.

Kirby, John C.—Private July 17, 1861. Discharged, disability, Oct. 7, 1861.

Knighten, Samuel E. (or Knighton)—Private Sept. 22, 1863. Wounded near Washington, D. C. July 18, 1864. Absent, wounded, Aug. 31, 1864. No later record.

Kolb, Harmon H.—Private Feb. 25, 1862. Killed at 2d Manassas, Va. Aug. 28, 1862.

Kolb, Richard S.—Private July 17, 1861. Wounded at Cold Harbor, Va. June 27, 1862. Died of wounds at home in Stewart County, Ga. Nov. 25, 1862.

Maree, James—Private July 17, 1861. Killed in Valley of Virginia.

Martin, Samuel P.—Private July 17, 1861. Died of typhoid fever at Camp Toombs near Centreville, Va., Oct. 15, 1861.

Martin, William H.—Private July 17, 1861. Discharged, disability, Jan. 30, 1862.

Mathews, Thomas T.—Private July 17, 1861. Appointed 2d Sergeant Dec. 18, 1861; 1st Sergeant Dec. 17, 1862. Wounded at 2d Manassas, Va. Aug. 28, 1862. Roll for Aug. 31, 1864, last on file, shows him absent on account of wounds. No later record.

May, James B.—Private July 17, 1861. Appointed 3d Sergeant Aug. 1, 1862. Captured at Petersburg, Va. Mar. 25, 1865. Released at Point Lookout, Md. May 14, 1865.
