

McElroy, Barney S.—Private July 17, 1861. Captured at Hagerstown, Md. Aug. 12, 1864. Released at Fort Delaware, Del. May 10, 1865.

McMickle, William D.—Private July 17, 1861. Appointed 3d Corporal Aug. 1, 1863; 4th Sergeant Aug. 1, 1864. Captured at High Bridge, Va. Apr. 6, 1865. Released at Newport News, Va. June 26, 1865.

Merceer, Green L.—Private July 17, 1861. Wounded at Sharpsburg, Md. Sept. 17, 1862. Discharged, disability, at Staunton, Va. Apr. 4, 1863.

Metcalf, George W.—Private May 1, 1864. Roll for Aug. 31, 1864, last on file, shows him absent without leave June 18, 1864. No later record.

Mimms, Henry (or Mims)—Private Sept. 29, 1863. Sick in hospital July 23, 1864. Returned to duty Sept. 23, 1864. No later record.

Moore, James J.—Private July 17, 1861. Roll for Aug. 31, 1864, last on file, shows him present. Died of disease in 1864.

Moore, John R.—Private Feb. 25, 1862. Died of disease at Culpeper, Va. Apr. 10, 1862.

Morris, James G.—Private July 17, 1861. Died of variola at Lynchburg, Va. Dec. 27, 1862. Buried there in Confederate Cemetery. No 18, 4th Line, Y.S.—Smallpox Hospital.

Morris, John A.—Private July 17, 1861. Wounded at Cold Harbor, Va. June 27, 1862; Sharpsburg, Md. Sept. 17, 1862. Roll for Aug. 31, 1864, last on file, shows him on detached service July 1, 1864. No later record.

Nolan, James—Private July 17, 1861. Captured at Winchester, Va. Sept. 19, 1864. Sent to Point Lookout, Md. Oct. 18, 1864. Exchanged at Venus Point, Savannah River, Ga., Nov. 15, 1864. No later record.

Owens, Irwin (or Irvin)—Private July 17, 1861. Discharged, disability, at Richmond, Va. Nov. 5, 1861.

Owens, James—Private July 17, 1861. Died at Charlottesville, Va. July 25, 1862.

Owens, James M. (or Omans)—Private July 17, 1861. Wounded at Winchester, Va. Sept. 19, 1864. Surrendered, Tallahassee, Fla. May 10, 1865. Paroled, Albany, Ga. May 29, 1865.

Parker, Francis P.—Private July 17, 1861. Appointed Ensign June 17, 1864. Captured at Cedar Creek, Va. Oct. 19, 1864. Sent from Baltimore, Md. to James River, Va. for exchange Feb. 1865. No later record.

Parker, James M.—Private July 17, 1861. Wounded at Cedar Run, Va. Aug. 9, 1862. Died of wounds Oct. 16, 1863.

Parmalee, Newton B.—Private Mar. 15, 1862. Appears last on roll for Apr. 30, 1863.

Petersburg, Samuel—Private July 17, 1861. Discharged, disability, at Sudley Church near Centreville, Va. Oct. 5, 1861.

Phillips, James—Private July 17, 1861. Died at Camp Wright, Va. Sept. 16, 1861.

Pierce, Capel—Private Feb. 25, 1862. Absent, sick, May 22, 1864. Died in Virginia.

Pope, John D. Wilson—Private July 17, 1861. Wounded, date and place not given. Admitted to General Hospital #9, at Richmond, Va. Feb. 8, 1865; given certificate of disability Feb. 9, 1865. No later record.

Pope, Littleberry B.—Private July 17, 1861. Discharged, disability, camp near Manassas, Va., Feb. 7, 1862.

Powers, Jesse M.—Private July 17, 1861. Wounded at Sharpsburg, Md. Sept. 17, 1862; Cold Harbor, Va. June 3, 1864. Appointed 4th Corporal Aug. 1, 1864. Deserted. Received at Washington, D. C., a Confederate deserter, Apr. 5, 1865. Took oath of allegiance to U. S. Govt. and furnished transportation to Savannah, Ga.

Prather, Jesse—Private July 17, 1861. Captured at Gettysburg, Pa. July 3, 1863. Took oath of allegiance to U. S. Govt. at Point Lookout, Md. and enlisted in U. S. service Jan. 25, 1864.

Price, James F.—Private Mar. 30, 1863. Surrendered, Appomattox, Va. Apr. 9, 1865.
