

Price, William E.—Private Feb. 22, 1862. Appointed Corporal. Surrendered, Appomattox, Va. Apr. 9, 1865.

Renfroe, Commodore L.—Private Sept. 9, 1861. Discharged, general debility and imbecility, at General Hospital, Culpeper, Va., Jan. 16, 1862.

Robinett, Wiley B.—See private, Co. G.

Russeau, John M.—Private July 17, 1861. Killed at Chancellorsville, Va. May 2, 1863.

Sapp, Lemuel—Private Sept. 24, 1863. Captured near Washington, D. C., July 12, 1864. Died of pneumonia at Elmira, N. Y. Dec. 22, 1864. Grave #1088, Woodlawn National Cemetery.

Sasser, Bryan S.—Private July 17, 1861. Died of variola in Hospital 2d Corps, Army Northern Va., Mar. 30, 1863.

Shirey, Augustus L.—Private Sept. 9, 1861. Wounded at 2d Manassas, Va. Aug. 28, 1862. Roll for Aug. 31, 1864, last on file, shows him present. Killed in service.

Skipper, John W.—Private Sept. 9, 1861. Sent to Richmond, Va. hospital Dec. 1861. Discharged, disability, at Richmond, Va., date not given.

Smith, Richard T.—Private Feb. 24, 1862. Supposed to have died Apr. 20, 1862.

Smith, William W.—Private Feb. 24, 1862. Admitted to General Hospital at Charlottesville, Va. with measles Apr. 26, 1862. Sent to General Hospital at Lynchburg, Va. Apr. 27, 1862, where he died May 6, 1862. Buried there in Confederate Cemetery. No. 7, 4th Line, Lot 168—Christian's Factory.

Spires, William—Private July 17, 1861. Killed at Fredericksburg, Va. Dec. 13, 1862.

Steptoe, Abram C.—Private July 17, 1861. Transferred to Co. D, 59th Regt. Ga. Inf. Mar. 14, 1863. Wounded at Ream's Station, Va. Aug. 25, 1864. Roll for Aug. 31, 1864, last on which borne, shows him present. No later record.

Steptoe, Henry—Private July 17, 1861. Discharged on account chronic bronchitis Dec. 13, 1861.

Stevens, John W. (or Stephens)—Private July 17, 1861. Wounded at Sharpsburg, Md. Sept. 17, 1862. Appointed 2d Corporal in 1863; 1st Corporal July 1, 1864. Killed near Charlestown, W. Va. Aug. 21, 1864.

Stovall, Josephus—Private July 17, 1861. Wounded at 2d Manassas, Va. Aug. 28, 1862. Surrendered, Appomattox, Va. Apr. 9, 1865.

Tilley, Walter J.—Private July 17, 1861. Appointed Corporal Dec. 1, 1861. Killed at 2d Manassas, Va. Aug. 28, 1862.

Trammell, Cullen A.—Private July 17, 1861. Captured at Petersburg, Va. Apr. 2, 1865. Released at Point Lookout, Md. June 20, 1865.

Trammell, John A.—Private Feb. 27, 1862. Died at Farmville, Va. July 31, 1862.

Trippe, David L. (or Tripp)—Private July 17, 1861. Wounded at Cold Harbor, Va. June 27, 1862. Roll for Aug. 31, 1864, last on file, shows him on detached duty at Macon, Ga. Oct. 5, 1863. No later record.

Trotman, Colin—Private Feb. 25, 1862. Supposed to have died prior to Apr. 7, 1863.

Turner, Thomas J.—Private July 17, 1861. Wounded at Winchester, Va. May 25, 1862. Appears last on roll for Apr. 30, 1863.

Weeks, David M.—Private Feb. 25, 1862. Wounded in arm, necessitating amputation at shoulder joint, at Sharpsburg, Md. Sept. 17, 1862. Discharged, disability, Jan. 18, 1864.

Welsh, Bird—Private July 17, 1861. Wounded at Cold Harbor, Va. June 27, 1862. Died at Guinea Station, Va. Apr. 19, 1863.

Williamson, Henry C.—Private July 17, 1861. Admitted to General Hospital at Farmville, Va. June 23, 1862. Killed at 2d Manassas, Va. Aug. 28, 1862.

Worthington, Samuel W.—Private Mar. 5, 1864. Surrendered, Tallahassee, Fla. May 10, 1865. Paroled, Albany, Ga. May 17, 1865.

Yeomans, Redding—Private Oct. 21, 1863. Deserted. Received at Washington, D. C. Apr. 4, 1865. Following remark appears relative to him "Took oath of allegiance to U. S. Govt. and furnished transportation to Washington, D. C."
