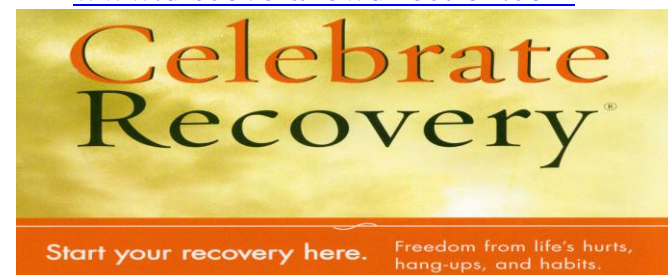

2009 finances

September giving was \$5,839.66, an average of \$1,459.92 per week, both the lowest of the year and compared to August \$8,327.11 (for five weekends), an average of \$1,665.42 per week.

(Average attendance was 100, up from August 93, but both months were higher only than January this year when we were having single services.)

Total giving this year is \$74,200.56 for an average of \$1,902.58 per week. To meet the budget of \$131,023.36 we need an average of \$2,519.67 a week. We pray for and depend on continued growth to meet our budget. A grant we had expired a year ago and we depend entirely on giving to meet our expenses. (Free Methodist rules prevent us from having fund-raisers like other churches, except for children programs like the quiz teens candy sales.) Some budget items have been set aside, but many operating expenses (including increasing insurance costs) must be paid. Also, additional expenses loom that had not been foreseen when the budget was adopted, such as new roof over the nursery (have you seen the tarp?) which we want to extend over the handicapped ramp to new handicapped accessible back door. We need to pay our regular bills (utilities, salaries) first, but for those who want to make ADDITIONAL contributions there are some items on our "wish list" (see elsewhere in this newsletter) which had not been included in the budget.

Contact the mission at 337-2516 for details, based on the following opportunities. Officials suggest calling before dropping something off as they are trying to keep the dining room mostly clear to be ready for the Thanksgiving meal.

Tax-deductible donations for the Rome Rescue Mission can be mailed to the mission at PO Box 337, Rome, NY 13442-0337 or dropped off at the mission, 413 E. Dominick St. Those who wish to automatically make monthly or quarterly donations can make arrangements to do that through their Visa or MasterCard credit card.

Volunteers are needed to: sponsor a dinner, deliver meals, or help in the food pantry, with clothing distribution, as tutors or in the computer lab, as an administrative helper or telephone receptionist.

The mission has a wish list including items for shelter, general use, pantry and office. The items needed for shelter are: single sheets, pillows, pillow cases, mops, cleansers, vacuum, brooms, compact lights and bulbs, bath towels, wash cloths, dish cloths, sponges, bath robes, hygiene items, diapers and devotionals. General items include tissue paper, hand tools, a carving knife and floor buffer. Pantry needs are canned goods, juice, milk, meat and poultry. Office items desired are copy paper, color copier and a fax machine.

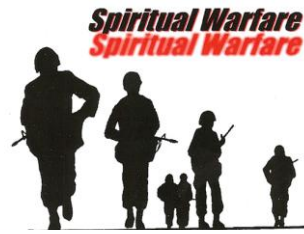

Participants open the door by sharing their experiences, strengths, and hopes with one another. In addition, they become willing to accept God's grace and forgiveness in solving life's problems. Celebrate Recovery provides a safe place for individuals to begin their journey of breaking out from their bondage and into God's grace (11 Corinthians 12:9), by helping them to start dealing with their life's hurts, hang-ups, and habits.

Worship is a major strength and difference between a Christ-centered and a secular recovery program. Worship provides a time for everyone to put aside the busyness and hassles of the world and get in touch with the true Higher Power, Jesus Christ. It allows time for the power of the Holy Spirit to fill all those who attend with a peace and a safety that only He can provide. The main focus of every fellowship event is to help

members develop healthy relationships that will grow into a support team of sponsors and accountability partners.

CR STEP GROUP - Wednesday 6:15

The Step Study community and process provide a structure for chaotic lives. Most of us coming out of the community of CR come from dysfunctional families. Our life may lack structure, or we have surrendered to unhealthy, destructive patterns. We need to learn new patterns, to build new structures into our lives.
