DARKNESS RISING IS A FONT BY DESIGNER
DAVID KERKHOFF WHO IS BEHIND HANODED FONTS.

David's main design focus is using hand written mediums to transform into fonts. The path in font design began when he wanted to make a website to sell his photography work and decided a hand-written font style would make the site more personal looking. When none of the online resources could provide him with the font he quite needed for his project, he pursued tutorials on the project and made his first font. Since then he continues to use traditional mediums to make fonts; such as calligraphy brushes, broken skewers, and so on. (Kerkhoff, n.d.)

This hand drawn design is apparent within Darkness Rising, which is only one of many fonts on his website. Darkness Rising was first hand written out with a broken skewer, and by skewer I mean those ones you see in some Asian restaurants that they use for Yakitori (skewered chicken).

According to the story behind the fonts design, he broke twenty-five skewers that day to try to get one just the right way, but none of them were working out. So, he took a break on this dreary day for him and came back to the work to break the lucky twenty-sixth skewer and it worked. The font was "brushed" with the broken skewers with Chinese ink. (Kerkhoff, Darkness Rising, n.d.)

The font I am using for the project, however, is the demo version of this font which can be used for free if it isn't for commercial use (YouTube, Websites, etc).
