



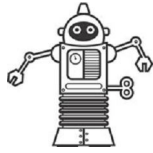

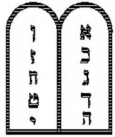

We'll have crafts, activities, songs, and fun for all ages!

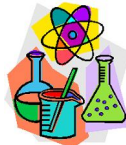
Join us at 9:00 AM as we explore our theme, "New Creatures!"

Pantry News



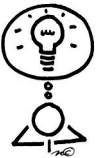
Sunday, August 23rd will be "Jello" Sunday for the Community Pantry.
