RULES OF THE HOUSEHOLD

January 2008

- All applicable federal, state, and local laws should be followed.
- Firearms, explosives, hazardous materials, and weapons are strictly prohibited
- Real life gambling or betting are prohibited.
- Smoking, unless in a private vehicle, is restricted to the designated area.
- Keep all references, comments, etc PG-13.
- Discussions and references involving real life religion, politics, and ALL offensive comments are prohibited.
- Ensure that outer doors are shut at all times. During the summer, the screen doors will suffice. This is to ensure that all animals remain in the house.
- The sliding doors to the game room will remain closed whenever the room is empty. Check to ensure that there are no cats in the game room when the doors are closed.
- Clean up your own messes. Trash must be thrown away by the end of the night. Any spills or debris accumulation needs to be cleaned immediately.
- Do not feed the animals.
- Do not touch the artwork. This includes props, statues, costumes, etc.
- Bedrooms, closets, and workshops are considered private areas and are not for public entrance.
- While the bar top may be used for gaming, behind the bar is off limits.
- The yellow bathroom will be utilized by SWGA members.
- If in doubt, ask before you do it. The house residents are happy to help.
- Do not touch or play with the game consoles or accessories
- Ask a house resident before using or changing the Televisions
- The Treadmill and exercise equipment is for the use of the house Residents only
- The Pool table is for playing pool only. Do not put anything else on the pool table
- if you play pool, put up the cues and the balls on their stand when you are finished
- The living room and pool room have hardwood floors, If wearing Cleats, boots, heels or other hard-soled shoes that may mark them, stay within the tile floor portions of the house (Game Room and Dining room)
- The driveway is for the vehicles of the residents only. Visitors must park on the curb.
- Use the carport door by the game room
- The Games Club is a public club, not a private gathering. Please remember to behave appropriately for a public venue.
- Respect the household residents schedules and restrict club activities to the scheduled club times.
- Sergeant of Arms may remove people for violating these rules or causing problems.
- House rules may not cover every possible situation. They may be changed, added to, or subtracted from with little or no notice.
