

- a. They (**1. haven't finished / didn't finish / finished**) their homework yet, but they are trying hard to finish it.
- b. The defendant was found guilty; (**2. therefore / because this / nevertheless**), he will be imprisoned.
- c. She (**3. have been / has been / is**) cleaning for the last 5 hours and still going on tirelessly.
- d. So far Naji (**4. won / has won / has been winning**) 3 championships in Ping-Pong. Moreover, yesterday, while we (**5. were playing / played / have been playing**) football, the telephone (**6. has rung / rang / had rung**) suddenly and it was Naji, telling us that he won one more championship.
- e. When I arrived at the party yesterday, Sami (**7. has already left / was already left / had already left**) so I couldn't see him. Note that when I met him last week, he (**8. promised / had promised / has promised**) me to come and here he breaks his promises again.
- f. Before John participated in the championship he (**9. has trained / had been training / was training**) for two months. Only those who (**10. had trained / were training / have trained**) in advance won medals.
