**Expectations:**

**Homework:** Daily homework will be assigned. The assignments basically cover the materials studied in class on that day or preview for the following day. Homework is very important because it measures a level of understanding of what students learned in class. Homework must be done cleanly and neatly. Incomplete, sloppy or late homework will not be full credited or must be redone. Copied homework will be credited zero.

**Quizzes/Tests:** Quizzes will be given every week. Unit tests will be given occasionally. Weekly quizzes and unit test are given based on the material covered prior to each period. Pop quizzes are given without announcement and can not be made up. Cheating will be credited zero on that assignment.

**Note Taking/Material Organizing:** Students are responsible for organizing their study materials. Their notebooks/binders will occasionally be collected and checked.

**Class Participation:** All students are expected to meet every day and to participate in class in a polite and considerate manner. Tardiness and bad material preparation will impact their learning and lower the grade. No food or drink is allowed in class and the use of any electric devices, including cell phones and music players, is prohibited. Simply follow teacher's instructions and respect the personal and property rights of others.

**Makeup Work:** Students are responsible for requesting any makeup homework assignments upon returning to school after an absence. Makeup quizzes/tests must be taken immediately before or after school by appointment. No makeup work, including quizzes/tests, will be given in the event of truancy or other unexcused absence.

**Language Learning:** Students will be learning and practicing the four major components of language: reading, writing, speaking and listening. Each of these is an active skill and will require practice every day in class and out of class. In order to become proficient at a foreign language, students need lots of practice with new vocabulary and grammar, as well as pronunciation. Taking notes and organizing/keeping materials are also very important to review what you learned and they will help you study for quizzes or tests.
