

Southeastern Ohio USBC

Youth Championship Tournament

- 1 All USBC rules will be observed. All entrants must be USBC certified.
- 2 All Southeastern Ohio members are eligible to enter. See Rule 300c for non association members.
- 3 Teams will consist of **4** bowlers which may be Open or All Girls.
Doubles will consist of **2** bowlers which may be Open or All Girls.
If there are fewer than four entries in any division, they will be combined with the next division.
- 4 Bowlers may move up one (or more) division(s) in team and doubles events. All bowlers must compete in their own divisions for singles. All-events handicap and position is based on the bowlers actual division.
- 5 All classifications bowl three games in each event. Handicap will 100% of 200 for all participants.
Bowlers from different age divisions may bowl together.
Teams/Doubles with male and female bowlers will compete in the Open division per USBC guidelines.
- 6 Bowler may participate only once in singles. To allow for substitutions, entrants may bowl twice in doubles and team events. Entrants may place only once in the awards list for position standings.
First appearance in each event counts toward all-events.
- 7 **Current seasons' highest average as of October 25, 2008 will be used. All bowlers must have at least 9 games of bowling in their league.** If no average, bowler must use a scratch average of 120 for bantam bowlers; 150 for preps; 180 for juniors; 200 for majors and seniors. Non members bowl scratch.
- 8 No entry will be considered without required information and the fully paid entry fee.
All entries must be received by the tournament manager or be postmarked prior to midnight November 1, 2008.
- 9 Entry fees are non-refundable after the entry has been processed and dates are assigned.
Circle the date and time you prefer to bowl. **Every effort will be made to give you this time, HOWEVER, this may not possible.**
- 10 The coach must verify averages and sign the entry form. Members with averages in more than one league must ensure their highest league average is reported. The average may be corrected up to the end of the first game of the first squad bowled. Corrected averages will be rerated to the proper average and division.
- 11 All awards fees will be returned 100% on the basis of at least one per ten entries.
- 12 Team and doubles partners will bowl in the order listed on the entry form. Any change must be made not less than 24 hours prior to squad time. Substitutions may be made if reported at least 45 minutes prior to squad time. All substitutes assume the position of the bowler replaced.
Refer to rule 322b for absentee provisions.
- 13 Teams must check in at least one hour prior to squad time.
- 14 Awards are presented in handicap and scratch divisions, with handicap taking precedence.
- 15 The tournament will start Nov. 8, 2008 and conclude Nov. 22, 2008. Doubles squads are held at Lincoln Lanes and Team squads are held at Scenic Lanes. **Bowlers arriving late will receive a zero in all frames missed. There will be no exceptions.**
- 16 Total pins, plus handicap where applicable, determine the winners.
- 17 If there are ties scores involving awards, duplicate awards will be made.
- 18 Errors in scoring must be reported no later than the start of the next squad, or 30 minutes after the tournament completion. Rule 329 will apply.
