1st Annual Southeastern Ohio USBC Open

The 1st Annual Open Tournament is completed. Waiting until the last squad was the **1st place team**, the Orange Carpet Lounge. Jim Spires, 587; Bill Foltz, Jr., 701; Dan Cass, 686; Alan Beavers, 671 and David Spires finished with 612 for the winning total of 3257 in the actual division and 3716 in the handicap division. The 2nd is held by the Eagles III team with 3599 and 3rd is the LBA Senior team with 3497. 2nd in the actual division is Mattress Etc... rolling a total 3241 followed closely by Fred's Moped Shop with 3239. **Low** in the money in the handicap division is 3433 and **low** in the actual division was 3239.

1st place in the doubles handicap, the winners are Tom Bolden, 156, 212, 204 for 572 & Ryan Daubenmire rolled 297, 278, 253 for 828, totaling 1400 actual +91 pins for 1491 to win. 2nd is held by; Dave Leupold & Bill Newlen with 1442 & 3rd is Todd Mohler & Chuck Rankin with 1439. **Low to cash** is 1354. **Actual doubles** went to Keith Miller, 203, 213, 255 for 671 and Chuck Rankin, 188, 243, 214 for 645 totaling 1316. 2nd are Brian Currence and Ryan Beers, 1296, followed by Todd Mohler & Chuck Rankin with 1288 for 3rd. **Low in the money** is 1253.

Singles handicap division winner is Chuck Rankin with 255, 238, 300 for 793 plus 21 pins for the 814 total. 2nd is Ryan Beers with 796 & 3rd is Kenny Wince totaling 776. **Low score to cash** is 695. **Actual singles** went to by Ryan Beers rolled 259, 279, 258 for a 796 series. 2nd is Chuck Rankin with 793 followed by Ryan Daubenmire with 739. **Low in the money** is 644.

All Event handicap winner is Early Ruff rolling a total of 2221 followed by Ryan Daubenmire with 2154, and 3rd was Bill Ludwig totaling 2144. **Low in the money** is 2028. **All Events Actual** 1st place score of 2138 was rolled by Ryan Beers, in 2nd place, Bill Ludwig totaling 2090 and 3rd is Todd Mohler rolling a total of 2023. **Low to cash** is 1874.
