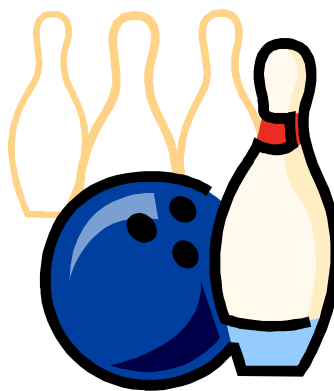
## Lancaster Women's 600 & Lancaster 700 Club Tournament Held

The SEOHUSBC will present an award for the most pins-over-average series bowled for the period of Jan. 6, 2008 thru Feb. 2, 2008. There is no cost for the entry, but each member is responsible for reporting their scores to Alice Snider, 220 Talmadge Ave. Lancaster, OH 43130 no later than Feb. 9, 2008.

#### THE RULES ARE:

Winner will be decided by the most pin-over-average in a 3 game series in regular league play based on current average (of 12 games or more) in the league at the time the series is bowled.

There will be four divisions for the women and the men. Women's division: Averages up to & including 125; 126 up to & including 140; 141 up to & including 155; and 156 & above. Men's division: Averages up to & including 149; 150 up to & including 170; 171 up to & including 190; and 191 & above.

You may be a regular or a substitute bowler provided the games requirement is met.

There will be three winners in each division. Cash awards will be: 1<sup>st</sup> place \$20, 2<sup>nd</sup> place \$15 and 3<sup>rd</sup> place \$10.00.
