Two City Record Scores Broken at Starlite Lanes On The Same Night!

On February 26, 2004, a 19-year city record for a 3-game series by a 3-women team was broken by Diane King, Cate Kimple and Kathy Dennison rolling an 1803 series during league play in the Thursday Starliters at Starlite Lanes. On February 2, 2006, Team PITA members Diane King, Darlene Travis and Kathy Dennison of the Thursday Starliters broke that record within two years shooting an 1846 series that consisted of Darlene's 676 scratch total with games of 207, 245 and 224 secured by matching 585 pin counts from Diane and Kathy. To top off the night, the trio broke the 15-year record of a 3-Women Team Game of 672 in their second game of the night's series shooting 677 with 245 from Darlene, Diane with 238 and 194 from Kathy. The city records have stood for years, but they can be broken as proved by these ladies.
